

Haringey Aquatics Code of Conduct for all Committee Members, Officials and Volunteers

- At all times adhere to the ASA Rules, Regulations, Code of Ethics and Equity Policy
- Always adhere to ASA Wavepower Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures and refer all concerns of a child safeguarding nature in line with the procedures contained in Wavepower.
- Adhere fully to the role and job description for any task undertaken for the club and never use your position to gain favour for yourself or any individual participant not to impose your personal views and opinions on other members.
- Consistently display high standards of behaviour and appearance.
- Treat all swimmers with respect and dignity, value their worth and treat everyone appropriately and with equity recognising their individual needs and abilities within the context of the sport.
- Encourage and guide participants to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance.
- Continue to seek and maintain your own development in line with your role and complete a Safeguarding Children in Sport course if appropriate to your role.
- Treat all information of a personal nature about individual swimmers as confidential except in circumstances where, to do so, will allow the child to be placed at risk of harm or to continue to be at risk of harm.
- Encourage all participants to obey the spirit of the rules and regulations both in and out of the pool.
- Never encourage or condone members to violate the rules of the club or British Swimming and report any violations appropriately.
- Observe the authority and the decision of the officials and only question decisions in an appropriate manner.
- Treat all competitors and other club teams with respect, whether that is in victory or defeat and encourage other club members to do the same.
