## Code of Conduct – Returning to the Pool

In order to ensure the safety of its members, Haringey Aquatics swimmers are required to read and adhere to the code of conduct which incorporates guidance issued by the Government and our Governing Body, Swim England.

The club has appointed a Covid Lead <mailto:welfare@haringeyaquatics.org.uk> and a pool of Covid Officers who will be present on poolside throughout the training sessions in order to comply with Swim England and Government guidance.

- Swimmers must arrive on time (at least 5mins prior to lesson but no more than 15mins). Swimmers arriving more than 5 minutes late will not be able to swim.
- Swimmers will be required to follow the set procedure when entering and exiting the building, this is shown in the video sent to all members and will be reinforced by our coaches and covid officers. Failure to adhere to these procedures may result in the swimmer not being able to attend further sessions.
- Changing rooms and shower facilities will not be available. Swimmers should arrive swim ready and leave with their costumes on underneath clothing.
- Swimmers must maintain a social distance of 1m+ (or as advised by Government) at all times.
- Lane capacities will be in accordance with Swim England guidance
- Spectators will not be permitted.
- Parents/guardians must drop off and collect their swimmer outside of the leisure centre remaining contactable by mobile throughout the sessions
- Drink bottles and equipment must be clearly labelled and not shared at any time. Coaches will advise swimmers which equipment is needed prior to the next session.
- If you have been exposed to anyone with confirmed or suspected Covid-19 in the past two weeks you will be unable to train until you have self-isolated for ten days. Please inform the Covid Lead as soon as possible if you have been told to self-isolate for this or any other reason.
- If you have an underlying medical condition or are at higher risk due to Covid-19 you will not be able to swim at this time. Please contact the Covid Lead to discuss.
- Please note that we may adapt our current plans as guidance changes. We will inform you of any changed plans but ask that you continue to monitor the website for updates.

By signing this code of conduct you are indicating that you have read and understood the information above and agree to adhere to the code of conduct.

Unfortunately swimmers that have not returned this signed document will not be able to take part in any training sessions.
