1. The competition will be held under Swim England laws, Swim England Technical Rules of Swimming and these Promoter's conditions. Enfield Swim Squad will liaise with the pool operators regarding COVID and COVID safety management by the pool operators, in addition to any rules and regulations in place by the Government at the date of this meet. Whilst plans are in place for Enfield Swim Squad to produce a document indicating necessary protocols, this will be published as soon as possible, but in the current pandemic, may be subject to change. All participants will be required to agree to this as part of the opt into this meet.
2. The Meet has been licensed at Level 3 by Swim England, license no 3LR220580. There are no Qualifying Times, but there are Upper Limit Times and NT (No Time) entries are accepted for this meet. The closing date for entries is midnight on Friday, 17th June 2022. Confirmation of accepted entries will be returned by email as soon as possible after this date.
3. Ages as on the day of the meet – 16th July 2022.
4. The pool is 25m long with 8 lanes, anti-wave lane ropes and Colorado electronic timing system in operation.
5. In the interests of time, 'over the top' starts may be operated at the discretion of the referee.
6. An electronic entry system will be operated at this meet. Swimmers must withdraw using the appropriate form at the relevant desk no later than 15 minutes prior to the start of each warm up.
7. Swimmers must report to the clerks of the course when instructed to do so. Any competitor not reporting in time may be excluded.
8. Swimmers must be Swim England registered at category 2 (Club Compete) and have a Swim England number and be a member of an affiliated club.
9. All events will be swum as combined age groups and seeded slowest to fastest irrespective of age.

10. Time trials may be available to swimmers at the promoter's discretion and dependent upon space and will incur a fee of £10 payable before the race takes place. All time trials will be swum in the first heat. They will not be eligible for medals. No refunds will be given except where entries are rejected.
11. The entry fee will be £6.50 per event for all 50m, 100m and 200m events (this includes the SWIM ENGLAND's 20p levy). No refunds will be given except for rejected swims and for Covid-related reasons with proof of a positive test. Clubs with more than 5 swimmers should enter electronically by using Hy-Tek's Team Manager Software. This can be downloaded from Hy-Tek's website. Please complete the [electronic entry summary form \(https://forms.gle/zPegwHJ4VgSiNGhp6\)](https://forms.gle/zPegwHJ4VgSiNGhp6) and submit the Hy-Tek entry file to essopenmeets@enfieldswimsquad.org. Payments must be made when the form is submitted to: Enfield Swim Squad, HSBC, sort code 40-22-34, account number 61471260. Entry times must be 25m pool times. Any club with 10 or more swimmers is asked to provide a SWIM ENGLAND registered official (J1, J2, J2S, TK, Referee), for each session.
12. Government Coronavirus laws permitting, spectator entry will be £7 per person, per session or £10 per session for both sessions.
13. Coaches passes are available at a cost of £15 each per day, to a maximum of 4 per team. This includes lunch and refreshments between each session. Swim England Guidelines state that the ratio of swimmers to "minders" should be 10:1. Passes must be displayed at all times. No one will be allowed on poolside without a pass.
14. Entries should be emailed to essopenmeets@enfieldswimsquad.org. The [entry summary](https://forms.gle/zPegwHJ4VgSiNGhp6) should be submitted electronically (<https://forms.gle/zPegwHJ4VgSiNGhp6>). The closing date is midnight, Friday, 17th June 2022, or sooner if full; entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis. All entry forms must be fully and correctly completed, otherwise they may be rejected. Electronic entries are mandatory for more than 5 swimmers, unless by prior agreement of the promoter. Clubs sending paper entries will be required to pay a £10 administration fee. Hy-Tek file available from the promoter on request.
15. Withdrawals before the event will only be accepted up until 14th July 2022. Any withdrawals after this date must be made at the commencement of warm up at each session at the latest.
16. The age groups are Age Groups for awards: 9yrs, 10-11 yrs, 12-13 yrs, 14-15 yr, 16 & Over.
17. Awards will be given to the first 3 in each age group in each event, on a HDW basis.
18. The events are:
 - a. 50m & 100m all four strokes, all age groups
 - b. 200m Freestyle, all age groups
 - c. 100m Individual Medley, 11 yrs and under
 - d. 200m Individual Medley, 12 yrs and over
19. A secondary strobe will not be available at this Meet.
20. Results will be available on the club website as soon as practicable after the meet. A full set of results will be sent by email to all clubs. **Please ensure a correct email address is provided to us with your entries.** The personal information supplied with your entry will be retained securely and will only be used for the legitimate purposes of running the event. This data will be shared by form of results with Swim England (Rankings) and the clubs who have entered the meet. A full copy of the results will be published on the website after the meet. from our website may take you to external websites that are not covered by our policies. Please ensure that you review their privacy policies before any data is submitted. If any persons want to exercise their right to erasure or processing of their personal data they will need to make a written request to the promoter. We will only hold competition data for 12 months after which it will be destroyed and erased from our systems.

21. All participants and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at the pool and follow instructions of pool staff and the Enfield Swim Squad Management Team. Prior to leaving poolside, swimmers must dry off and put on appropriate clothing and footwear. No swimmers will be allowed into the spectator area or the main entrance foyer area unless they have complied with this requirement.
22. By submitting their entries, swimmers accept these conditions in full. Failure to comply with any condition may result in suspension from the competition and forfeiture of any fee paid. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator to any session.
23. **Video Recording/Photography/Mobile Telephones:** In accordance with the conditions for the pool hire, any person wishing to engage in video, zoom or close range photography, including the use of mobile telephones with photographic capabilities, must first register their details on the form provided at the entrance desk. They will be provided with an identification label (permit) which must be worn at all times. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse the granting of a permit. It is requested that all mobile telephones are switched off or turned to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each event. There may be a designated official videographer/photographer.
24. **No photography or filming of any kind is permitted in the changing rooms or village. Anyone found contravening this requirement will be required to leave the facility without refund.**
25. All persons attending the competition are advised to exercise reasonable care when taking photos or video, particularly with regards to the sharing of images on social media. Wavepower guidance should be followed at all times.
26. No photography by competitors should take place at the venue at any time during the meet - this includes from admittance into the center **and** until they have left the building.
27. Safeguarding concerns should be reported to the Promoter. If the concerns relate to conduct of the Promoter, a report should be made to the Chairman and Welfare Officer of Enfield Swim Squad.
28. Enfield Swim Squad reserves the right to amend the Conditions, without prior notice, to ensure the smooth running of the meet. For any matters not covered by these Conditions the promoter will make any decisions they deem necessary to provide for the satisfactory running of the competition. By submitting an entry participants have deemed to agree to such decisions.
29. All visiting clubs must ensure that team managers/coaches and officials comply with WavePower.
