Policy for Club Captains in ASGARD Swimming Club

The positions of club Captains will be voted in each year before the Easter Break. There will be one male and one female Club Captain.

Role Description

A good club captain is a person who

- All athletes can talk to about any issues they may have.
- Gives input to club committee meetings and represents the views of the athletes.
- Is a positive role model for all members of the club.
- Communicates with fellow team members, and provide support and advice where needed
- Encourages club members to be involved in social and voluntary activities
- Welcomes new members to the club

<u>Criteria</u>

- Must be over the age of 15
- Must be an active competitive member of the club
- The person should not have had any disciplinary measures of note taken against them.

Procedure

- 1. CCO's will explained to the eligible swimmers the criteria and role duties
- 2. Any Swimmer over 15 can add their name to the sheet on the notice board. This indicates they wish to be nominated.
- 3. The parents of all nominees will be contacted to ensure that their swimmer has agreed to run for the position.
- 4. All nominations will be ratified by the club committee, to ensure that they fill the required criteria.
- 5. Voting will take place before training sessions in the week leading up to the Easter break and the successful club Captains will be announced on a given date before the break.
- 6. The new club Captains will take up their role in the third term of the year.
