Promoter's Conditions

1: This competition is promoted by Erith and District Swimming Club which is affiliated to the Swim England London Region and Dartford District Swimming Club which is affiliated to Swim England South East Region. It is to be held under Swim England Laws and Technical Rules of Swimming and Promoter's Conditions. The event is licensed by Swim England for entry to County and Regional events. The event will be held in an eight lane 25 metre pool with electronic timing pads and display. There is a secondary strobe on the starting machine.

2: Ages are as at midnight on 7th November 2021. In all events, awards will be made to the first 3 placed swimmers in each stroke / distance / age group with age groups being 9yrs, 1yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs and 15yrs and 16yrs+. It is the swimmer's responsibility to ensure his/her eligibility for each event. All swimmers must be registered as Category 2 with Swim England.

3: All events will be swum on a HDW basis and all heats will be spearheaded. All starts will be at the deep end of the pool and over the top starts will be at the discretion of the Referee.

4: Closing date for entries is 10pm on the 20th October 2021. Entries may be accepted after the closing date and up to the start of the warm up for each session, subject to space availability. Any entries accepted after the closing date will be classed as Time Trials, meaning that the swimmer will swim for time only and will not be eligible for an award. Their time will be submitted to the Swim England Rankings.

5: One combined entry per Club with one payment. Clubs will need to submit entries electronically using Hy-Tek's TM Lite. Further details on how to do this are available as part of the electronic entry pack.

6: Entries will not be registered unless accompanied by the correct fee. Payments must be made to the EDSC bank account: 09 01 55 / 59306709

8: Coaches and Team Managers' Passes are £25 to include admittance to poolside at all sessions and refreshments. Passes are transferable and Coaches and Team Managers will not be allowed on poolside without a Pass. The Promoter has the right to ask any unauthorised persons to leave the poolside. Coaches and Team Managers' Passes must be ordered using the Club Entry Form.

9: A card-less entry system will operate at the gala. There will be no sign in. All swimmers will be entered in to every event they are registered for. Swimmers wishing to withdraw from an event in session 1 / 2 / 3 should do so by e-mailing openmeetentries@edsc.org.uk by 6pm on Friday 5th November. Swimmers wishing to withdraw from events in session 4 / 5 / 6 should do so by e-mailing the same e-mail address by 6pm on Saturday 6th November.

10: Competitors must report to the Clerks of the Course in the marshalling area when called. Competitors not reporting in time for an event may be excluded.

11: Competitors are only allowed on poolside for the session in which they are competing. They must also cover up and wear shoes when leaving the poolside area. It is not permitted to bring glass containers on to poolside. All rubbish must be taken off of poolside when leaving.

12: Entries must be equal to or faster than the Lower Qualifying Time LQT (where applicable) and no faster than the Upper Limit Time (ULT) published for each event.

13: Time trials for swimmers whose times are faster than the ULT may be accepted after the closing date and up to the start of the warm up for each session, subject to space availability. Time Trials will not be accepted from swimmers who have qualified for the equivalent event(s) in the Regional short course Winter Championships which run concurrently with this Meet. Swimmers whose entries are faster than the ULT will swim for time only and will not be eligible for an award. Their time will be submitted to Swim England Rankings. The Promoter reserves the right to restrict the number of entries to meet allocated pool time. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Any entries not accepted will be refunded in full.

14: The Promoter reserves the right to alter the schedule if circumstances demand and any item not covered within these conditions will be at the discretion of the Promoter.

15: Spectators are not allowed on poolside at any time.

16: By submitting and accepting entries to the meet consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information. The personal information supplied with your entry will be retained securely and will only be used for the legitimate purposes of running the event. This data will be shared by form of results with Swim England (Rankings) and the clubs who have entered the meet. A full copy of the results will be published on the website after the meet. Please be aware that links from our website may take you to external websites that are not covered by our policies. Please ensure that you review their privacy policies before any data is submitted. If any persons want to exercise their right to erasure or processing of their personal data they will need to make a written request to the promoter. We will only hold competition data for 12 months after which it will be destroyed and erased from our systems.

17: PHOTOGRAPHY – anyone wishing to take still or digital photography (including using mobile phones to do this) must do so in accordance with the Swim England Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures (Wavepower). Flash photography is prohibited at all times. Imaging equipment must not be used in the changing village.

Additional Covid procedures and protocols

DDSC & EDSC look forward to welcoming you to our Fireworks Meet. The promoter reserves the right to adapt this meet to align with UK government guidance and policies on Covid restrictions.

The meet will only take place if Covid restrictions allow and is currently being planned on the assumption that no social distancing rules will be in place. The club are working with the team at Crook Log Leisure Centre to ensure that this meet can operate safely. Everyone involved has a duty to protect each other.

If restrictions require us to cancel the meet, entry fees will be refunded.

If anyone planning to attend the meet has any Covid symptoms, they must not attend. We will continue to monitor government guidance with regards to self-isolation for those who have been in contact with someone who has tested positive and ask that anyone involved with the meet abide by the guidance available at the time.

Clubs must have current contact details for all swimmers, team managers, coaches and officials attending in case these are required for track and trace purposes. Clubs will be responsible for the swimmers from their club whilst at the meet and should bring sufficient team managers for the number of swimmers in each session.

We will only be accepting club entries. There will be no individual entries due to requirement for Team Managers

We will only have use of the pool deck around competition pool. Swimmers are not permitted on to the pool deck unless it is a session in which they are competing. There will be no sign in on the day. Swimmers will be entered for all of their events. If a swimmer wishes to withdraw then they should follow the instruction in Condition 9.

Spectators will be limited to 125 per session. To allow us to manage numbers in the balcony, anyone wishing to spectate **must** purchase an entry ticket in advance by clicking [HERE](#). Once you have purchased your ticket you will receive an e-mail confirmation of your order. Please retain this confirmation as you will need it on the day to gain access to the balcony. The balcony will be cleared at the end of each session and only once cleared will the next set of spectators be allowed in to the Centre.
