

# DISABILITY LIAISON ADVISOR

## Role

To play a key advisory role with those working with disability athletes within aquatics

## Main Duties

- To liaise with the County Disability Liaison Officer
- Arrange disability awareness training for club volunteers, teachers and coaches as relevant
- To identify any additional training needs within the club in relation to providing opportunities for disabled swimmers
- Ensure that any disabled members are aware of the training and competitive swimming opportunities available to them
- Maintain a list of local disability sports organisations with contact details
- Develop links with local disability swimming clubs (such as Bingham Penguins) and disability sports organisations
- Advise the club on how to promote opportunities for disabled people through club publicity materials
- Follow and promote the clubs Child Protection policy
