Enclosed please find entry details for the Leinster Future Challengers Plus Meet (Level Two).

This meet is open to all swimmers registered with Leinster clubs aged between 10 and 14 (as of Dec 31<sup>st</sup> 2023). Events offered are all the 50m, 100m and 200m events, with mixed relays also. The meet incorporates the Future Challengers series; the top 8 swimmers in each event (excepting the 200m Breast, Back and Fly) will score points towards their club total (but restricted to two scoring swimmers per club per event, with each swimmer only eligible to contribute points from two individual events).

Eligibility	Only swimmers registered with Leinster clubs, aged between 10 and 14, are eligible to enter this gala. Ages are as of December 31 <sup>st</sup> 2023					
Entries	Gala Sec, Leinster Swimming. Entries, on Hy-Tek only. Entries should be emailed to leinstergalasecretary@swimireland.ie					
Important entry conditions	Swimmers who have Consideration Times for four or more swims at the Leinster Long Course Championship (May 12 <sup>th</sup> to 14 <sup>th</sup> ) may not enter this Future Challengers meet. Swimmers who have Consideration Times for three or fewer swims at the LC Championship may enter this FC meet, but not in the events for which they have LC Championship Consideration Times. A fine of €250 will be imposed on a club found to enter a swimmer in both this Future Challenger Meet and the Leinster Long Course Championship 2023 in a manner that breaches these entry conditions.

Entry Limits	Swimmers can enter no more than 5 (five) individual events in the meet.					
Consideration Times	There are no Consideration Times for this Meet					



Scratches	Scratches for this gala will close at <b>5pm</b> on the evening before the gala; that is <b>5pm</b> on Saturday May 6 <sup>th</sup> 2023. Scratches to be sent via email to <u>leinstergalasecretary@swimireland.ie</u>				
Awards	There will be no individual awards, but awards will be made on a team basis, as follows:				
	a. Top three highest scoring teams on completion of Round 1 and Round 2 (male and female combined)				
	b. The most improved team between Round 1 and Round 2 (male and female combined)				
	Winning teams will receive a certificate to present on their club notice board and competing athletes will receive a wrist band.				
Scoring	a. Each club will be awarded points for a maximum of <b>two scoring results</b> per individual event and one scoring result per relay event per age group. This rule has been set in Meet Manager, so teams do not need to nominate scoring swimmers in each event in advance.				
	<ol> <li>Individual Events – 10-14 years, but the younger swimmers may not swim in the longer events.</li> </ol>				
	II. Relay Events – 10-12 years and 13-14 years				
	b. Points will <b>NOT</b> be awarded in the 25m Kick event				
	c. The top 8 individual and relay scoring places will be awarded points as follows. For example, if athletes from Club A finish 1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> , 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> they are only awarded points for 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> place with points for 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> going to the athletes finishing 5 <sup>th</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> and so on.

Wristbands	Swimmers who achieve Grade 7 times or better will be awarded wristbands appropriate to their achievement. The time bands for the relevant grades are provided below. Graded Times are not age-dependent.				
Note on times achieved	Please note that this is a Level Two meet. Times achieved at this meet will not be eligible for qualification to national events, such as the Swim Ireland National Division Two meet.				
Heats	Clubs will be notified in advance as to any changes to the competition.  Numbers of heats may be curtailed to allow the gala to be run off in a reasonable time-frame.				
Session Start Times	The Start Times of sessions as indicated in the Order of Events may be changed in the light of entries received and the logistics of running the Meet within Swim Ireland regulations relating to Session duration etc.				
Officials	Clubs must provide officials in a ratio of one official to every four swimmers for each session (this includes the senior gala officials). A rota for club				



officials will be circulated as early as possible in advance of the meet.

Swim Ireland Registration Number	A Swim Ireland registration number must be included with every entry. This number is the unique identifier of every swimmer in the national database.			
Entry Name Protocols	The results from this Championship Meet will be added to the Swim Ireland and Leinster databases. To ensure that results get attributed correctly to swimmers, please ensure the format of names within your Team Manager (or similar) database, and provided with entries, is as follows:			
	All those with a Mac/Mc surname need to have a space after the Mac/Mc (e.g. Mac Dougal, Mc Donnell);			
	All those with an O need to be written as e.g. O'Donnell (no space before or after the apostrophe). This is irrespective of whether or not that is how the swimmer normally writes their name.			
Complaints	Clubs are reminded that the only club representatives who are permitted to enter a complaint or to otherwise approach the Referee, Meet Director or Gala Recorder are Coaches and Team Managers			
Code of Conduct	It is a pre-condition to a swimmer being entered for a Leinster Region gala that all parents / guardians who attend and/or assume officiating duties (timekeeping etc) have consented to be subject to the SI Code of Conduct.			
Data Protection	Leinster Region, Swim Ireland uses a computer database to manage entries and results of swimming meets, and also to manage competition records of swimmers. By submitting and accepting entries to the meet consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act, to the holding of personal information on Leinster Region computer databases. Personal data held for each swimmer will be name, date of birth, club, Swim Ireland registration number, entry times, achieved times and DQ codes. Certain elements of this data (name, club, age, times, achieved times) may be made public prior to, during or after the meet (e.g. programmes, results, Meet Mobile, etc).
