

## OVERSEAS MEETS

### Extracts from the British Rankings Policy on Overseas Meets

Clubs, Squads and Individuals who have obtained permission to compete abroad may have results included in the rankings providing the competition is accepted for rankings by the relevant Home Country Federation. Any individual athlete who relocates to train and/or study must similarly obtain such permission. All permits must be obtained in advance. Results from such overseas competitions may be included providing they are achieved in competitions equivalent in status to meets licensed in England, Scotland or Wales. **Results must be submitted within 28 days of the competition** in a suitable format for uploading into Rankings. Please contact [rankings@swimming.org](mailto:rankings@swimming.org) to obtain full information before travelling.

### **Information required by Rankings if you are competing in an Overseas Meet.**

If you are a team competing abroad and wish to have your times entered into the British Rankings. You must have received permission from your Federation to swim abroad. Email [Rankings@swimming.org](mailto:Rankings@swimming.org) They will provide you with the Overseas Meet spreadsheet. Which you will need to complete and return to Rankings (within 28 days) along with a link on the web where we can check the details.

An individual swimmer competing in an overseas competition and requiring the times to be entered into the British rankings must provide the following information. It must be submitted within 28 days following the competition:

- Full name.
- Date of Birth.
- Registration Number.
- Name of GB Club of which a member.
- Which events the competitor competed in.
- Details of the competition.
- Official Result sheet and a link on the web where we can check these details.
