



Conditions for Club Records

Effective from 1st January 2019

1. Club records can be achieved at any competition run under ASA/FINA rules in which the swimmer is representing Leicester Sharks as an individual in a licenced meet. Records may also be made by swimmers representing either a county, region, nation or university providing the athlete completes a minimum of 90% of their training with Leicester Sharks C.S.C.
2. To be eligible for a club record, a 10yrs & over swimmer must
 - a) Be a fully paid up member of Leicester Sharks at the time of the swim
 - b) Have completed the race in a licensed event, with electronic timing and qualified referees and judges.
 - c) Achieve a faster time than the existing record. Achieving an equal time will not be considered.

A 7yrs, 8yrs or 9yrs swimmers must:

- a) Be a fully paid up member of Leicester Sharks at the time of the swim
 - b) Have completed the race in a competition run by Leicester Sharks, or in a team gala at which Leicester Sharks C.S.C. have attended.
 - c) Achieve a faster time than the existing records. Achieving an equal time will not be considered.
3. The times compared must be the 'Official Times' published by the organisers of the gala.
4. Club Records will be maintained for both long (50m Pools) and short course (25m pools). Club Records will not be maintained for any other length pools.
5. Club records will be maintained for Male/Female athletes for the following ages and events:
 - a) Ages: 10yrs & under, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs, 16yrs, 17yrs, 18yrs, Open
For events: 50m/100m/200m/400m/800m/1500m Freestyle
50m/100m/200m Butterfly
50m/100m/200m Backstroke
50m/100m/200m Breaststroke
200m/400m Individual Medley
100m Individual Medley (Short course only)
 - b) Ages: 7yrs, 8yrs, 9yrs
For events: 25m/50m/100m/200m Freestyle
25m/50m Butterfly
25m/50m/100m Backstroke
25m/50m/100m Breaststroke
100m/200m Individual Medley
 - c) Ages: 16yrs & under, 17yrs & over, Open
For events: 4x100m/4x200m Freestyle Relay
4x100m Medley Relay

6. The record compared against will be for the same age of the swimmer as on the date of the swim. (E.g. if a 10yr old boy swims up in a 12/u event, the record compared against is still for a 10yr old boy)
7. The times considered for a new record must be achieved in an individual swim.
8. Only the complete time for the entered distance will be compared to the existing record.
