### PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

Once you have signed these codes of conduct you will remain bound by the codes for the duration of your association with Edenbridge Swimming Club

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

- Punctuality  
Ensure your children are:  
Poolside five minutes prior to training sessions.  
Poolside ten minutes prior to warm up at all galas.
- Friendliness  
Be friendly to all new swimmers and their parents, encouraging them with their involvement with the club.
- External swimming  
The Head Coach must be notified in writing prior to a swimmer taking part in any external competition or training facility not organized by the club, so that consent can be given.
- Discipline  
Parents not complying with the Code of Conduct, maybe asked to leave the session, be suspended for several sessions or in extreme cases, asked to leave the club.

#### BEHAVIOURS

- Provide a model of good sportsmanship for your swimmers.
- Ensure your swimmers enjoy their sport in a respectful safe and friendly environment.
- Encourage your swimmers independence by making them responsible for bringing and looking after their equipment.

#### SUPPORT

- Encourage your swimmers to have a healthy diet, drink fluids during the day (2 litres per day) and have enough sleep.
- When at the pool take your turn at time keeping, fund raising and other club or committee activity.

#### COMMUNICATION

- Ensure that the club noticeboards, website and newsletters are read for important information about coming events, changes to training times etc. If you should have any doubts please liase with either a club coach or a member of the committee to clarify any questions you may have.

#### RENEWALS/ENTRY FEES

- Please pay renewal fees, meet entries and all other payments at the required time. If there is a problem with payments then please speak to the Membership secretary or Treasurer in confidence.
