Do we need volunteers? YES WE DO!

We rely heavily on volunteers to meet all of our aims. We TRY EXTREMELY HARD to ensure that we always have a sufficient number of qualified volunteers working within KASC, to ensure the smooth running of the club.

There are many different roles within the Club which we need volunteers for. Some of these are Committee roles (post holders are elected at the club AGM in November) and some are non-committee roles. People can start helping at any time.

Some of the roles we need are :-

Committee – Treasurer, Secretary, Welfare Officer

Press officer

Poolside helpers

Team managers

Officials such as judges/timekeepers

Volunteers can help at as few or as many sessions as they want. Competitive events (galas) are usually held on Saturday evenings and can be anywhere, but usually within the East Midlands region.

We welcome anyone who is enthusiastic! Most of our current volunteers are parents, ex-swimmers or current senior swimmers but we are working hard to encourage more parental help. We may also assist any members who wish to gain qualifications by paying a percentage of the cost of courses. We will also try to secure external funding.
