



Sudden Cancellation of a Training Session

It seems appropriate, with the recent appalling weather in the South East to remind all Swimmers and their Parents/Carers what CASC will try to do on the rare occasion's sessions needs to be cancelled.

In the event of a Centre having to close unexpectedly, after investigating the Health & Safety and Transport implications, the following steps will be taken*:

- Pool providers will contact the Swimming Secretary or another member of the Committee via phone (back up email as necessary).
- CASC Coaches will contact the Swimming Secretary if they are unable to attend a session.
- CASC will endeavour to advise all swimmers via a message on the website.
- CASC will endeavour to email all Parents/Carers of the squad affected.

In times of inclement weather, Parents/Carers are advised to check the website and emails regularly.

During periods of bad weather or civil unrest Parents/Carers are requested to check at pool side that a Coach is present.

If a session must be cancelled for reasons outside our control this will be recorded and will be constantly monitored. Appropriate action will be taken should this prove to be excessive within a reasonable period.

**This could also apply in an emergency if a coach is unable to attend and no cover available.*
