



CROYDON HIGH SCHOOL POOL- COVID 19 PROTOCOL

The protocols at Croydon High School Pool are quite simple and straightforward;

1. The swimming pool is located in the Sports centre by the top car park to the left of the main school building. Parking is available.
2. The entrance to the pool is at the back of the building to the left hand side of the car park by a metal gate. There is no entrance through the main door.
3. The swimmers should be going to the session "beach ready" this means with their swimwear on and in clothes that are easy to change out of and on as there is not changing rooms available before swimming.
4. At poolside the swimmers will follow the one way system. There is space for the swimmers to leave their bags at poolside.
5. The session should start on the far end of the pool and should finish at the far end of the pool as well.
6. When the session is finished the swimmers will follow the one way system into the changing rooms where they can get into dry clothes. Only 8 swimmers at a time are allowed in the changing rooms (8 girls/ 8 boys). We are aiming for a 5 minute turn around so the other group can come in after the first 8 have left. The swimmers waiting should make sure they are standing in line keeping distance from each other.
7. The changing rooms are communal, there are no cubicles, therefore the swimmers will need to be socially distant and give each other enough space to get changed.
8. Coming out from the changing rooms, the swimmer should go down the stairs using the side exit door which will lead them straight to the ground floor exit door, avoiding the main entrance.
9. Parents are not allowed to stay in the spectators' area, as there is not much space poolside. Please be on time and outside the main entrance (to the right side of the sports building) when picking up your child.
10. Parents need to go through these instructions with their swimmers and make sure that they understand the importance of following all these instructions. Swimmers who do not comply with the social distancing or blatantly disregard the protocols will not be allowed to train and be taken out of the pool or not being allowed to go back training until further notice.
