### Promoter's Conditions

#### Meet Level

1. The Meet is licensed at Level 3, licence number 3LR160688, and will be run under ASA laws, FINA Technical Rules of Swimming and these promoter's conditions. The competition is open to all swimmers who are at least 9 years old on the day of the Meet, and who are registered competitive members of the ASA.

#### Age Groups

2. The competition will be swum in the following age bands: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13 and 14 with ages determined as at Midnight, 3 July 2016).

#### Pool

3. The competition will be held in an 8 lane, 25m pool with anti-wave lane ropes.

#### Events and Entries

4. Events are 50m all strokes, 100m IM, and 200m freestyle for all age groups
5. Medley Skins Events

There will be skins events for the following age groups at the end of Session 1

- Girls ages 14 years and under
- Boys ages 14 years and under

Competitors will be those who have the eight fastest times achieved in the 100 IM earlier that day. Strokes for the skins events will be chosen at random on the night. Detailed rules for the skins competition appear elsewhere.

6. Entries must be made on the official individual entry **OR submitted electronically using the Sportsystems software that can be downloaded from our website at [www.BeckenhamSwimmingClub.com](http://www.BeckenhamSwimmingClub.com) (on the Open Meets page). Entries not submitted electronically will incur a charge of £5.00 per competitor.**
7. Entries will be accepted on a **first come, first served** basis, up to and including the closing date on Friday, 10 June 2016 (midnight). The club reserves the right to close acceptance of entries, earlier than the closing date if oversubscribed.

#### Fees and Payment

8. The entry fee shall be £5.00 per individual event.
9. Coach passes are £15.00 each (for entry, a programme, refreshments, and a 'finger lunch'). Results shall be posted on our website soon after the meet. Only swimmers and those persons displaying a coach pass will be allowed on poolside.
10. Payment for entries and coach passes must be made by a single cheque per club, to "Beckenham Swimming Club". Individual entries can also apply.
11. Spectator entry will be by colour coded wrist band and will be charged at £6:00 per day/£4 per session. If only attending the morning session £6 will be charged, however, on return of your wrist band and before the start of the afternoon session, a £2 refund will be given. Children under the age of 10 will gain entry free of charge.

#### The Competition

12. Over the Top Starts may be operated at the discretion of the Promoter (except for backstroke). The heats will be run all ages seeded together and the final heat of each event will be spearheaded.

### **Awards and Trophies**

13. The following shall apply:
- Medals will be awarded for the top three places, and ribbons for the next three in the 50m (all strokes), the 100m IM and the 200m Freestyle events in each of the age groups.
  - Special awards will be made for skins events.

### **Data Protection**

14. Meet entries will be managed on a computer. Your consent to the holding of personal information for the purposes of the Meet shall be treated as being given by the submission of your entries, as shall your consent for such details to be published both during and after the Meet.

### **Qualifying Times**

15. There are Upper Limit Qualifying Times for this Meet. Submitted times **MUST** be slower than the Upper Limit Times. **Please submit 25m pool times.**
16. The Promoter may check the ASA's Rankings tables for times achieved by swimmers 12 months before the Meet. If a faster time is recorded in the Rankings tables for the swimmer, the Promoter will substitute the entered time with the Rankings time. Any times submitted (or substituted from the Rankings tables) which are faster than the relevant Upper Limit Times shall be ignored and the proposed entry discounted with no refund being given. **Speeding tickets shall NOT apply.**

### **Video/Photography**

17. Anyone wishing to take still or digital photography (including using mobile phones to do this), must in accordance with the ASA Child Protection guidelines, register themselves with the Promoter on entry to the Meet.

### **Administration of the Meet**

18. There will be two sessions. A card-less entry system shall be used. Swimmers must sign in at the relevant desk at least 45 minutes before the start of the session.
19. Swimmers in the first event of each session **MUST** report to the clerks of the course at least 10 minutes before the start of the session, and others at least one event before the start of the event in which they are swimming. It is the swimmers' and their coaches' responsibility that they report to the clerks of the course on time. Failure to sign in, means that the swimmer loses the right to swim.
20. The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any spectator, coach or swimmer.
21. Conditions not covered in these competition rules shall be dealt with in accordance with the laws of the sport and at the discretion of the promoter.

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### SKINS CONDITIONS

1. There will be one Age Group: 14 years and under. Swimmers who competed at the 2015 British Gas National Championships are not eligible to enter the Skins event.
2. The eight fastest swimmers in the 100 metres individual medley will be invited to take part. Reserves will be selected, and swimmers advised by announcement. In order to ensure that all lanes are occupied please indicate within 30 minutes of the skins competitors being announced of your intention to take part.
3. There will be seven rounds, each round will comprise of a 50 metre race. Swimmers will be spearheaded for the first round in accordance with the times achieved in the 100m I.M. all seven rounds (save the final round in which the swimmers shall compete in the central lanes spearheaded in accordance with times achieved in the 100m IM) to be swum in the same lane.
4. The stroke to be swum will be determined by drawing a coloured ball from a bag prior to the start of each round. The stroke drawn will be announced as soon as it is drawn and again immediately following the whistle, prior to each round. The ball will be replaced in the bag after it is drawn.
5. The stroke selected must be swum in accordance with the FINA Technical Rules of Swimming.
- 6.1 The starting sequence in the first round will be in accordance with the FINA Technical Rules. The starting signal of each subsequent round will be given exactly 3 minutes after the start of the previous one.
- 6.2 In the second and subsequent rounds there will be no preparatory command "Take your Marks." This will be replaced by a whistle blast 10 seconds before the starting signal, which will be given by the klaxon. In the event of a failure of the starting signal this will be replaced with a shout of "Go" from the starter.
7. Any swimmer starting before the starting signal will be disqualified unless they return to the end of the pool and start normally.
8. Where available AOE will be used to determine the finishing order; the slowest swimmer will be eliminated in each round. In the event of unavailability or a failure of the AOE then manual placings will be used. In the event that one or more swimmers have been disqualified for an early start or other infringement of the FINA Technical Rules then the slowest swimmer will not be eliminated.
9. In the event that two or more swimmers are eliminated then the subsequent rounds shall continue without elimination until the appropriate round. For example if two swimmers are disqualified for a false start in round one, no swimmers will be eliminated in round 2. One swimmer will be eliminated in round 3 as normal.
10. In the event of a tie for last place, both swimmers will continue into the next round. In this event two swimmers will be eliminated from the next round. In the event of a tie in the final there will be a further round, the stroke being determined in accordance with rule 4. The starting sequence to be in accordance with rule 6.2.
11. It is the individual swimmer's responsibility to be in their starting position at the start of each round. The starting signal will not be delayed in the event that a swimmer is missing, or has suffered some other "equipment" failure.
12. Any swimmer receiving countdown assistance prior to the start will be disqualified.
13. The winner will be the swimmer who is placed first in the final round. Prizes will be awarded as follows: - 1st - £25, 2nd - £10. There will also be a prize of £5 for the winner of each of the first six rounds; in the event of a tie the prize money will be split equally.

**RED Backstroke**

**YELLOW Breaststroke**

**WHITE Butterfly**

**BLACK Freestyle**
