Chairman's Report

I am not going to bang on about the crisis in volunteering other than to confirm for the sake of those who may not have picked up on it previously that we will not be holding our Development Camps for 11 -14 yr olds this Autumn because we did not have a volunteer step forward to organise them.

We will though be holding Development Camps for 11 year olds only , in April, July and October 2019 based on the Swim England Talent Pathway template. This programme will be led by Helen Mack with the Coaching led by our County Coach. The Lead Team Manager will be Jo Ulyett. This will be for a maximum of 18 x 11yr old Girls and 18 x 11yr old Boys. The decision to adopt the Swim England programme will also prevent Coaches within the County being denied opportunities to be placed on Swim England courses.

The standard of competitive swimming within ONB continues to improve with, I understand , a record number of swimmers from ONB qualifying for Summer Brits or Nationals. We are hoping that our Inter Counties team in October will be able to continue to hold its own in Division 1 against much larger Counties. Thank you for Donna Wheatley for stepping forward to

undertake the administration of this, with support of course from Jo Murphy , and an increased input from our County Coach.

Finally a big thank you to Christine Rennie for all her help during her term in Office as County Secretary and also to Mandy Fuller for her year as President and the very best wishes to Sandra Wrenn as her successor.

AGM Treasurers Report 10/7/18

The current set of accounts is for the 12-month period 01/04/17 to 31/03/18 and have been audited of which a signed copy is available in the accounts folder should anybody wish to see them.

General Account

This period has seen the county award funding to the value of:

As at the 31/3/18 we have £1254.76 outstanding 2017/18 funding grants to be claimed for. The General account shows an excess of expenditure over income of £11454.49 which is £12166.59 less than the previous 12 months.

- County income increased by £1755.24 due to COBIS Games and swimwear sales.

- The County Expenditure has seen a reduction of £12166.59. The major contributions being:
 - Funding reduced by £9357.91 (predominately the funding of Timing equipment/Blocks at Oxford and Aqua Vale one off payments outside of the normal Funding)
 - County Gala increased £1056.85 due to COBIS games held at Stantonbury
 - Hire Charges increased by £466 as we now pay for the room hire at Bicester Pool
 - sports gear purchases reduced by £1685.26.

Competition Account

The Competition account shows a reduction of income over expenditure of £4717.42 to £7249.04 for this year's Championships increase over the previous 12 months.

I will check with Oliver if he is covering this!

 - Age group Ind/Relay entries increased by £1363.50 to £22818.00.

- The Championships expenditure increased by £5328.19

- The overall Pool hire charges increased by £4169.80 to £11369.80
- Entry refunds increased by £1035.75 to £3290.00
- Printing reduced by £692.00 as Oliver printed in house.
- Stationary increased by £192.57 to £718.2
- Expenses increased by £385.66 to £1020.01
- Sundry expenditure increased by £726.85 to £900.00, comprises of:
 - Commentator Fee
- Trophies increased by £1472.94 to £5859.76

There is potentially one outstanding invoice from Aqua Vale for £3750.00 (additional charge supposed to be added by Aqua Vale for loss of earnings). This has been accounted for in the Income and Expense.

Due to increased costs at Aqua Vale and the reduction in our only source of income a 4 year budget has been produced. Oliver has provided the estimates for the County championships for 2019 which he estimates that the championships will have a profit of £5267.00.

Estimated athlete development has reduced as we are no longer doing our own camps and now intend to follow the Swim England program for 11 year olds in 2019/2020 financial year. Plus the overnight stay before the inter-counties is also not being done this year and going forward.

The budget predicts that we would have an estimated net worth as at 31/3/19 of £28238.98. Estimated costs for the Swim England program for 11 year olds have been added for the 2019/2020 year.

Affiliation Fees, were suspended as SER provided an admin grant. As previously mentioned this has now stopped, I recommend that affiliation fee's for 2018/19 not be levied but to be reviewed for future years.

Finally I would like to thank Janet Smith for auditing the county accounts.

This has been delayed, as, the licensing panel require age groups finals in all 50m and 100m events, this includes the Individual Medley which has previously been, heat declared. This comes as somewhat of a surprise as this has not been the case for previous championships. I have emailed the licensing panel asking them to reconsider on this occasion as we've already had to lengthen the programme to accommodate the 1500 & 800 freestyle for the girls & boys.

In addition to the above having liaised with both Oxford Leys and Aqua Vale pools photography will be permitted at next year's championships, I am also working with Maxwell and Aylesbury swimming clubs to find a paperless solution for entries which I am hopeful will be fruitful.

I am pleased to confirm that we have already secured the majority of key volunteers for the 2019 programme from AOE, control, volunteers & official's co-ordinators & commentator etc.

The past year has again been extremely busy and with the introduction in to the calendar of the 2017 -2021 FINA changes challenges for Synchronised Swimming Clubs.

The first 2 sections of the new qualifying grade structure are underway with the third strand to come on board later this year.

In January a 2-day conference was held in Loughborough for judge updates and education on the new Fina changes. This conference also saw the Swim England synchro plan for changes to competition planning and the introduction of a “competitive season” structure for 2019. (National Age groups will be held in November 2018 but then again in February 2019). Locally organised competitions are held between May and July each year- some organisers have trialled this for 2018 and ONB clubs have been involved in competitions for the past 4 weekends . Needless to say this is having an effect on the swimmers, officials and parents apart from most swimmers taking part in school exams. Coaches and clubs have also got to plan to keep swimmers motivated for the other parts of the year when there will be months without competition.

There were good results at national level competitions for ONB swimmers with Laura Turberville from Witney earning a place on the England Age Group Squad for 2018 –from National Age group results and training camp trials and selections. She has recently returned from International competition in Croatia where she placed 22nd out of 144 competitors in figures (5th placed of the England Swimmers) and the England Team Routine gained a silver medal. Subsequently she has been chosen to remain in the Squad to compete in Seville later this month and also be a member of the England age group squad pre-swimming at the European Championships in Scotland in August. Congratulations to Laura for all her hard work and achievements over this past year.

Also from their National Age group results Eleanor Bisp and Kata Soros were selected to the Regional Beacon squad. Kata was also selected with Rowan Bisp as part of the South East Regional squad and attended a training camp in Spain in May. Louise Fuller was also selected to attend the Spanish training camp as a coach. The Witney swimmers and coach all “enjoyed “the opportunity for hard work during the camp and have brought new training methods back to Club.

Both ONB Clubs have continued to compete throughout this year and known results are attached separately .Witney were able to take a squad of swimmers to the Scottish Nationals for the first time in approximately 10 years – all swimmers enjoyed the experience of competing on a different stage and setting than they are used to. Witney were also able to compete at the 2018 British Championships for the first time and combined with two swimmers from Cheltenham to enter the Combination Routine section. It was a good experience for swimmers and coaches to combine with other Clubs and network in this way.

Henley took 12 swimmers to Spain in April for a successful Club organised training camp.

Both ONB Clubs have continued to be part of the Club Network and a Sports psychology seminar was held for parents, swimmers and coaches. Both ONB clubs continue to be part on Swim Mark gaining their annual health checks.

On a personal note I have enjoyed my term as County President and have attended the County Championships and National County Championships in Sheffield. Thank you to everyone who has supported me over the year and wish an enjoyable year to the new President for 2018 – 19.
