# AGM Treasurers Report 8/7/14

The current set of accounts is for the 12 month period 01/04/13 to 31/03/14 and have been audited of which a signed copy is available in the accounts folder should anybody wish to see them.

### **General Account**

This period has seen the county award funding to the value of £1916.70 Coach Education and IT equipment, as at the 31/3/14 we have £1991.98 outstand funding grants to be claimed. The General account shows an excess of expenditure over income of £3370.41 which is £1062.70 more than the previous 12 months.

- County income increased by £899.06 due to increase in swimwear sales income.
- The County Expenditure has seen a increase of £1961.76. The major contributions are:
  - o sports gear purchases increased by £1469.22
  - Hire charges increased by £548.00 primarily due to Officials training
  - o IT spend down by £591.88.
  - Athlete Development (National Training camp not done) increase by £790.00

### **Competition Account**

The Competition account shows and reduction of income over expenditure of £6993.55 which is £567.97 less than the previous 12 months. This Profit was more than expected as we have again seen a reduction in Aqua Vale costing.

- The Championship income saw an increase by some £1583.94
  - Age group Ind/Relay entries reduced by £1600.00 increased
  - Admission door entries increased by £550.45
  - o Reduction in ASA sponsorship £500.00
- The Championships expenditure increased by £2151.91.
  - o Catering increased by £863.66
  - The overall Pool hire charges increased by £1099.60 primarily due to BLC
  - Entry refunds increased by £2130 (lower overall numbers entered)
  - Note: Sundry expenditure for £545.49 comprises of:
    - Charitable donations of £465.49 (together for short lives)
    - Gifts for outgoing County Captains £40.
    - Room hire for county debrief £40
  - There was an outstanding Invoice for 400m events held at Aqua Vale for 2012, estimated at £2254.35 which has been written back.



#### **Creditors Account Income & Expenditure**

This is a phantom account primarily used to track the funding grants, but also holds the 2012/2013 Aqua Vale outstanding invoice. As previous mentioned in past exec meeting that funding request older than 2 years would be written back. Therefore a total of £1718.48 was written back. The creditors Account outstanding balance stands at £10374.74, this is made up of the following:

This year saw another successful Championships, though we did have a few issues with equipment (starter box) and a couple of software issues. This year we saw One British record broken by Lucy Chenery for 800m Freestyle S14 Disability record. There was also an impressive 96 Meet best times and 17 County Short course records which highlights that the standard of swimming is yet again is continuing to improve.

We were made aware of the changes that British Swimming is proposing for the Competition Structure in the future. We hope that British Swimming will notify us as soon as possible (hopefully no later than the end of September). With that in mind no information will be circulated to clubs until we have finalised the detail for the 2015 County Championships.

All Age Groups will be Age as at 15<sup>th</sup> March 2015, unless the ASA change to age as at 31/12/15. **Note the proposed British Swimming changes also impact on the Age criteria which will exclude 9&10 year olds.** 

The proposed format for the 2015 championships is intended to be the same as in 2014 (subject to age restriction). Also note that the new competition structure does away with BAGCATs



Qualifying time for 2015 Championships will be, Accepted times 2009 A Grade times -7% and considered times are Accepted times +9%. This should provide us with a reasonable window to cope with either competition format, the considered times being marginally faster than this years.

Qualifying period will be from 14<sup>th</sup> April 2014 or from the 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2014 to either 15<sup>th</sup> December 2014 or 19<sup>th</sup> January 2015, this means that times achieved at SER Youth Champs can be used.

The Pools, Bletchley Leisure centre has been booked for both dates and Aqua Vale has been provisional been reserved for either of the main weekend dates, though these need to be booked by the end of September.

On behalf of the County Executive and the swimmers I would like to thank all of the people for giving up their spare time and helping at the championships without their dedication it would not have been such a success. Special thanks goes to Wayne Patrick the awards trustee, the pool co-ordinator Anne Minihan, Sharon Evans & Sarah Powell for operating the Meet Manager software, Jonathan Smith & Kevin Glass for operating the AOE and Finally for one last time to Peter Shaw for carrying out the duties of the promoter on the event days.

### 2014 Annual Report -Synchronised Swimming

This past year has been busy and has seen growth in synchro swimmers throughout the County.

Congratulations should again go to Emma Critchley who was awarded a place on the England Talent Squad for the third year. This time at Level 3 and has attended several residential camps and has represented England in Croatia at the recent Primorje Cup competition in both in figures and in Team where they were placed first. Emma was also selected to the senior GB squad and competed for GB along with Genevieve Randall (already a HPC athlete) earlier in the year. (Both swimmers started their synchro journey at Witney and in fact family homes are within sight of each other in Faringdon).

Unfortunately it was at this competition in Paris that the Synchro community was shocked by the news that the appeal against the total cut of funding by UK Sport had failed. This left the Senior GB squad and coach with no financial support despite Synchro having surpassed its' set targets for several years. It is a great shame that synchronised swimming is a growing sport in the country but with no chance to progress to its full potential.

For NAG's 2013 Witney were able to send figure competitors and two teams and Henley Synchro sent three teams all swimmers competed well.

A Beacon Club scheme has started with Reading being the nearest – there are 4 Beacon Clubs across the country each of them covering a vast area. Currently links with our Beacon Club remain as before.

The Witney squad have competed at several events throughout the past year with several successes and swimmers have worked hard to try and achieve the requirement of flat or over splits on land for the newly designed skill levels.

Witney Synchro successfully underwent their first Swim 21 Health check under the new system. Louise Fuller attained her Level 2 Coaches Qualification; Steve Fuller updated his Referee, Senior Skill Assessor and Presenter qualifications.

Henley Synchro sent a team to the British Championships this year for the first time and were able to attend more officials training days, Witney synchro ran a team managers course for 12 at Henley in May.

We would also like to thank our president Heather, for her support throughout the year at events, attending and presenting the medals. The swimmers really appreciate the support given by the county and the President.
