It was a great relief that the Main Weekends were able to go ahead at Aqua Vale in February, if for no other reason than the substantial loss of revenue that cancellation of the Championships would have created. This is a timely point to remind our Clubs that ONB, during 2016 alone, distributed nearly £16000 in Funding grants. Add to that the cost of the Training Camps for 11 -14 year olds in September and October, the County Squad's training and overnight stay for the National Inter Counties , Long Course Training in early Summer for National Qualifiers , and our contribution to the training hopefully of 32 new L1 Coaches and 12 L2 Coaches this year , and you can easily see why the loss of the £10k profit from the Counties would be critical.

Though Regional Overseas Camps and the very imminent Long Course season reduced the appearances of some of our top swimmers the Championships progressed well, appeared to run very smoothly and there were no major incidents once the flooding of the pool deck abated!

Though the crisis of last Summer's imposition of a 16yr & over age group seems a long time ago, and it is still considered to be an unnecessary move when it could easily have been made optional for each County to fit in to it's own particular situation with regard to older swimmer retention, I feel that the introduction of 16 & O A & B Finals worked well and has gone some way to mitigate the effect of the loss of the individual 16 year age group.

Obviously the Clubs views of this are very important and the time to have your say is at the De – Brief Meeting on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> April.

For those attending the very best of luck at the British Championships in Sheffield in April.

## **Swimming Secretary Report 14/03/2017**

The 2017 County championships concluded successfully thought there was some worrying times with Aqua Vale Pool with the repairs being finished days before the first main weekend. This issue has highlighted the reliance on Aqua Vale pool to enable us to run the Championships in its current form. There would have been some difficult decision that would have had to been taken in order to attempt to run the main weekends at our alternative pool. #### **County Synchro Report**

#### **March 2017**

Since January the reported changes in Synchro have started to happen:

- Swimmers achievement levels (competition entry requirements) have now changed from the Competitive Skill Levels and Recreational Grades to a system of 3 strands of Grades – Figures, Routines and Land (due to start in 2018).
- All levels of assessor are no longer all Levels of Assessors will have to retrain as judges if they have not previously held judges qualifications
- New Judge Levels have come in –now known as Level 1, 2, 3 and the training courses for these have now started –despite some major problems over unanswered questions over the course and requirements.
- Update/ change over courses will soon be run for 2017.
- All judges will have to update qualifications in 2018.
- New Competition framework is to be in place for competitions held after June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- New Levels of Competition Licence and guidelines to go alongside this just finished.

Several candidates from Henley and Witney attended a recent Judge level 1 course in Reading. Results are yet to be known.

Swimmers have attended Beacon training and England Talent Development Squad camps and have expressed their thanks on receiving Bursaries from County.

Clubs have been working hard on adapting to the initial changes that have come in and will be facing never ending challenges throughout 2017.
