<u>County Synchro Report</u> <u>January 2014</u>

I am very sorry that I can't attend the meeting this month.

Since the last report, Witney and Henley Synchro Clubs attended the National Age groups at the end of November 2013.

In the 9-12 years section there were 16 Clubs competing – Witney came 8th and Henley 14th

In the 13/14 years Henley came 6th out of 6 routines

In the 15-17 years section Henley came 6th out of 6 routines

In the 19 & under years section Witney came 14th out of 18 routines

The number of teams competing has increased over the last few years and this looks good for the future of synchro all over the country.

In the competitive figures Witney had two entries in the 12 & under section, Laura Turberville and Madison Squire are both 10 years old and coped extremely well competing individually at this high level of competition and are already planning this year's event in December. They were placed 13th and 14th in the 10 & under section with Laura being placed 0.0919 above Madison.

Emma Critchley, 14, who swims at Witney and Reading gained podium places in Solo, Duet and Team and came 4th in figures. She qualified for England Talent Squad trials and has subsequently been picked for the England Junior team to compete internationally later this year. Emma has also been chosen to train part time at the High Performance Centre in Aldershot with a view to joining the GB squad.

Witney held their Christmas Display on Sunday 15th December which included swimmers from Club and "Learn to Synch" classes. In all 32 swimmers were able to show the work they've been doing during 2013 to a variety of capabilities. Witney were very grateful to Heather Patrick and her mother for attending the event.

The Witney squad is busy working on strength, stamina and flexibility ready for the coming year and also on a routine for Sport Relief after being approached by organisers in the region to choreograph and perform a routine showcasing swimming, walking and cycling. Interesting times ahead and I will report back at the next meeting.
