The first day of 2020 County Championships competition went well and the feedback thus far has been positive. While we still have sixteen galas to go I would like to thank all those involved in running the first two galas.

I am pleased to share that the paperless entry system appears at this stage to have worked well and all competing clubs entered via this system, all entries were submitted in a timely manner with only a few minor hiccups; consequently, I was able to release the qualifying entries within seven days of the closing date.

The total number of individual entries amounted to 3673 (vs 3542 in 2019), 303 of which were rejected which is circa 200 more than last year and mainly from the freestyle events. There were 313 relay entries (vs. 343 in 2019), 0 rejected.

Unfortunately, no Para-swimming or entries from Bourne End SC were submitted; and all entries from Bletchley SC were rejected based on the entry cut.

I look forward to four more weekends of competitive swimming and hope to see many of you poolside.

#### **New J1 Course**

I attended Loughborough on Sunday for a presentation from Swim England on the new online J1 training.

Go live date is 27th January 2020.

Upfront fee of £20 which will include license (£10) so all new qualified officials will be licensed. It is not clear who is required to pay the upfront fee. SE Region have stated that they are not prepared to pay the cost up front, instead expecting clubs/county to pay. However, SE Region will reimburse £10 once the person has qualified as a J1.

Poolside training must be completed within 11 months minimum of 15 of which 3 must be at L1or L2 and 3 at L3 or L4 – trainees not allowed poolside until theory has been completed (apart from for TK assessment).

Tutor/mentor only allocated once theory modules have been completed.

No applications will be accepted for old J1 course license after 31 Aug 2020 and all training must be completed by 31 July.

#### **Support from Swim England to recruit officials**

Free Adverts for Technical officials on 'Careers in Aquatics' this will also allow Swim England to raise awareness on social media. If there is enough call from the swimming community this could be widened to include other meet volunteers.

They are also looking at producing a technical officials bulletin which will be distributed to qualified officials who have not withheld consent for contact – officials need to check what they have ticked as many are missing out on opportunities
