## Para Swimming Championships 2022 Supplement

(S1-S14 Held under Swim England Laws and the World Para Swimming (WPS) Rules of swimming)

## **PROMOTERS CONDITIONS SUPPLEMENT**

The general conditions for the Championships shall apply to the Multi-Classification Para Swimming events except where varied by any of the following conditions:

1. The Events

The above events will take place at Aqua Vale Sports & Leisure Centre Aylesbury, which has a disability hoist located at the start end of the pool.

Note: Competitors may enter any other events in the championships providing they have gained the appropriate qualifying time, but these will not be classed as multi-classification para swimming events.

2. All competitors (WPS Classification \$1 – \$13) must have an authorised British Swimming or where applicable WPS Swimming classification, which is held on the British Swimming or WPS Swimming classification database at the time of entry. Competitors in category \$14 must hold or have applied for INAS-Fid or national classification.

## Please note that swimmers with an \$15 classification are not eligible to swim in multi-classification para swimming events as per the Para-Swimming pathway.

- 3. All competitors must hold a current WPS classification at the time of entry and a copy from the British Swimming Membership data base must be supplied with entry form.
- 4. Multi-classification para Swimmers must be a member of a club affiliated to the County Association who is eligible within the meaning of Swim England law and must have been a registered member of the club in whose name he is entered at least 60 days prior to the first day of competition which is 8<sup>th</sup> January 2022.
- 5. Submitted times for all events must have been achieved between 17<sup>th</sup> May 2021 and 5<sup>th</sup> December 2021 inclusive and may be achieved in either a long course or a short course pool. Time Trial times will be permitted providing they have been achieved under appropriate conditions per WPS/Swim England Laws and Technical Rules of Racing. The closing date for the submission of entries is 7<sup>th</sup> December 2021.
- 6. A copy of the competitors WPS Classification from the British Swimming Website must be submitted with the swimmer's entry form.
- 7. All classes of swimmers will swim together (multi-classification para). The promoter reserves the right to combine events dependent on the number of entries
- 8. Should a swimmer with a Para Swimming Sport Classification swim a time in integrated heats that qualifies them for the relevant age group or open final, they should not be debarred from competing in that final.

- 9. Results will be calculated as recommended by the WPS.
- 10. Awards will be presented to the top 3 for each multi-classification para event. Presentation will take place at the end of the session.
- 11. Multi-classification para Swimmers will be judged under the relevant WPS Swimming Rules.
