2021 Arena League we were promoted to the premier London division so we had some tough competition and came away with 7th place finish out of 16, a great result for the swimmers who took part.

Winter Regions we had good results across the team with PBs throughout the swimmers who qualified.

Swim England put Lesley forward for UK coaching focus 2 programme and UK women's programme which she was successful on getting into – Other coaches are on these programmes from multiple sports so excellent to have been selected.
