- I understand the advice in regards to using the toilet facilities and understand the Club advises no toilet break in an hour session, however if I have to use the toilet facilities I Will wash my hands and use hand sanitiser and not touch my mouth or my nose.
- I understand that if I am late, by no fault of mine/my parents that I will not be able to participate in the sessions due to safety restrictions.
- I will respect other people's feelings through these hugely different times on poolside.
- I will ensure my behaviour is in line with what the Club requires, and I will adhere to all procedures and protocols in the safety briefing.
- I understand that if I do not adhere by the safety rules that I will be asked to leave the training session.
- If I am worried about anything, I will contact our Covid-19 Team, Welfare Team or use Google Classroom to help me.
