



Guidance for swimmers returning from University and/or Boarding School

Camden Swiss Cottage Swimming Club are proud to be able to offer training to all swimmers returning from University and Boarding School in accordance with the following guidelines:

1. Swimmers who are ASA Category Two registered with CSCSC can return to swim at CSCSC at the discretion of the Head Coach during school/university holidays.
2. Swimmers meeting the requirements for the performance squads will be accepted subject to a review of the current squad numbers, along with their availability to compete at Arena League fixtures should the club require.
3. Swimmers who do not meet the requirements for the performance squads will be offered a place in another squad within the Club subject to squad numbers and at the discretion of the Head Coach. The allocation of such a place will be discussed with the parents of the swimmer if under 18 y/o.
4. Parents are requested to advise the Head Coach of their swimmers intentions regarding training prior to the commencement of the academic year (including term dates).
5. Swimmers who potentially may wish to return to swim at CSCSC should advise the Head Coach upon acceptance to boarding school/university.
6. It is the expectation that the Coach at the School or University contact the CSCSC Head Coach to discuss the coaching programme.
7. Any allocation of a place to a returning swimmer is subject to a suitable place being available. The arrangement will be reviewed annually and progression to the performance squads will be considered at the appropriate time for any swimmer who is initially not placed in the performance squads.
8. All returning swimmers must complete and return the CSCSC Code of Conduct along with registering as an associate member on the CSCSC website prior to training.
9. The annual training fee for returning swimmers will be £180 and is payable by 30th September each year.

The annual club membership fee & ASA Category Two membership will also have to be paid by the 30th September each year.
