Event Information and Entry Forms

General

1. The competition will be swum under Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing and licensed by Swim England for entry into County and Regional Competitions. Any rules not covered by the Promoter's conditions will be covered by Swim England Laws on Open Competitions.
2. All competitors must be Swim England Registered and must be Category 2 members of a club affiliated to Swim England, Swim Wales or Scottish Swimming. Competitors not Swim England registered may enter at the meet promoter's discretion and must give evidence of registration to a FINA recognised international swimming federation.
3. The meet is inclusive and entries will be accepted into events from SE category 2 disability swimmers who will be swum fully integrated with able-bodied swimmers in appropriate heats and with reasonable adjustments made to meet their needs. A secondary strobe will not be available.
4. During the competition and to facilitate it's smooth running the Referee may amend any competition condition. All participating clubs will be made aware of any amendments.

5. All visiting clubs with 8 or more swimmers are kindly requested to provide a qualified and licensed official to assist with officiating in each session. Severnside Tritons will not refuse entries from clubs who are unable to supply qualified officials. The meet promoter will endeavour that there are sufficient officials/timekeepers to meet the license requirements for each session. If this proves not to be the possible for a session, times from that session will not be submitted to Swim England rankings. The meet promoter will forward an Officials Reply Slip with your Confirmed Entries.
6. Coaches/Team Managers are responsible for their swimmers at all times.
7. All meet competitors and spectators must observe all safety precautions in operation at Hutton Moor Leisure Centre and follow any instructions given by Leisure Centre Staff.
8. Competitors are advised not to leave their belongings unattended. Neither Severnside Tritons Swimming Club nor Hutton Moor Leisure Centre can accept responsibility for any property that may be lost, stolen or damaged.
9. Please can all attendees read the advice information on photography as set out in our Meet Programme and displayed in Poster Form at the Meet Entrance Table. The full Swim England guidance on photography can be found in Wavepower the Swim England Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures available at:<http://www.swimming.org/swimengland/wavepower-child-safeguarding-for-clubs/> . It is requested that all mobile phones are switched off or to silent during the competition and that there is no flash photography at the start of each race.
10. With the submission of entries, consent is deemed to have been given, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to hold and distribute as necessary, any personal information on computer, to run the meet.
11. The Promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator who exhibits rude or aggressive behaviour such as using foul language.
12. The Referee's decision is final subject to Swim England Laws and Regulations and Swim England Technical Rules of Racing.

Age of Competitors

13. The age groups for this competition shall be based on age as at midnight on the 5th June 2022.
14. Age categories shall be grouped as 9/10, 11/12, 13/14, 15/16 & Over for awards

Entries

15. The closing date for entries is midnight on the 1st May 2022. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Promoter, but not to the detriment of entries received on time. Entries received without payment will not be processed.
16. The entry fee is £7.00 for each event. Entries from clubs must be made electronically and submitted via e-mail using software compatible with Hy – Tek only. Individual entries may be made using the entry form and via e-mail. Club entries must be made by BACS or with a single cheque for all entries. Cheques should be made payable to ‘Sevenside Tritons Swimming Club’. Our Club Bank Details are available on request. Please arrange for the Summary Sheet, Hy- Tek entry and fee report together with your cheque for payment covering entry fees and coach passes to be posted to the Address set out below. For individual entries please post a copy of your e-mail and your cheque.

18. Entries will be confirmed by e-mail only. It is the responsibility of the club entering the competitors to check for any inaccuracies in the confirmed entries. Any inaccuracies must be notified to the Meet Promoter prior to the competition.
19. Incorrect or incomplete entries will not be accepted. Entries are accepted on the basis the competitor accepts the Promoters Conditions.
20. All Entries are subject to the Upper Limit Times specified on the separate sheet. Entries may be restricted in order to keep the session times within appropriate

time scales. If the entries are oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis.

21. No refunds will be made to competitors who withdraw after advice of acceptance.

22. Coach/Team Manager Passes are available up to a maximum number of three per club and will cost £12.00 each. Names of the Coach/Team Manager must be submitted at the time of applying for a Pass along with their Swim England and DBS Numbers. Passes must be worn conspicuously at all times. It is the responsibility of the participating club to ensure their poolside staff have up to date DBS clearances.

Events

23. Events shall be:

Stroke
50m Free, Back, Fly and Breast
100m Free, Back, Fly and Breast
200m Free, Back, Fly and Breast
100m and 200m I.M.

24. All events will be run on a Heat Declared Winner (“HDW”) basis. Entries will be seeded into heats from submitted times, with the slowest heat first and all heats spearheaded. Short Course Entry Times should be submitted.

25. All starts where possible and where agreed with the Referee will be over the top.

Awards

26. Awards will be given to the top three placed competitors in each age group in each individual event.

27. Awards can be collected from the Awards Table once announced.

28. There will be trophies presented to the Top Boy and Top Girl per age group and Ange Marling Shield presented to the Top Visiting Club based on points awarded for individual event performances. Award of trophies will be made on the basis of the acquisition of the highest points total throughout the Meet (3 points for first place and 2 points for second place etc). In the event of a tie the number of 1st places etc will decide the winner. Trophies will be presented at the end of the meet.

COVID-19

- 29.** Referee is responsible for ensuring that racing is conducted safely and any issues should be reported to the event organiser. The event organiser has the overall responsibility for ensuring the meet is running as per the risk assessment, and in line with the Government guidelines.
- 30.** Each swimmer needs to complete a Swim England Return to Competition, Covid-19 and Risk Awareness Declaration form, within 7 days before the competition.

- 31.** Risk assessment has been agreed with the venue operator as part of the venue hire agreement.
- 32.** Swimmers don't need to wear a face covering while exercising, but may choose to wear a face covering at all other times when at an indoor sports facility.

Officials, volunteers, coaches and medics are also not required to wear face coverings while present in a work or volunteering capacity but may choose to do so.
- 33.** As per the event plan and risk assessment in line with the pool operator restrictions, numbers during warm-up/swim-down may be restricted and consideration may be given to having single age or single sex sessions.
- 34.** Refunds for entry fee in the case of an athlete having to withdraw due to testing positive for COVID-19 will be considered.
- 35.** The facility operator guidelines on spectators being allowed to attend indoor events and limits on capacities will be followed. Liaison with the venue operator will continue to ensure that up to date guidance regarding spectators is followed and a robust risk assessment plan will be agreed.
- 36.** All equipment should be sanitised before use including starting blocks and backstroke start devices and again during dormant periods. Sanitisation products or chlorinated pool water can be used to sanitise the poolside equipment.
