Discussion on whether the February meet is at the right time and will be well attended? Discussed agreed only Chris and Adrian to meet(Jamie to facilitate). They were at the meeting where all the meets were agreed between CoB and United Bristol.

- 1. **update from Sean on the Uni** (funding and new squad), update from Chris on Monkton (new squad): discussed Chris to be allowed to contact Monkton and report back.





#### • 2. Constitution, Category 2 members, Arena:

Arena league :Sean wants to be involved in Arena league asap the deadline for application is March at which time we will need to be a stand a lone club so the fee of £2000 will not be incurred. Discussion: Julia queried this decision as Emily had recommend that we 'park' Arena League until the growth from the new squad is underway and the club is sustainable. Sean disagreed and said Emily just wants to keep the Network clubs happy.-committee disagreed and said we need to take the advice given, but were happy to ask her again to explain her advice and whether it was to concentrate first on becoming self sustaining financially and to be in a more secure financial position for the long term. Sean said that this was important to him that we join ASAP. Reminded that there had been a vote previously and the vote went to wait until Chris was sure it was right for the club. (Chris not present so unable to ask his opinion).

Committee discussed that with the changes required to the constitution — advice from Alan and Emily would be needed about what the requirement changes are that are needed and Karen asked that we ask Emily her advice on Arena League. If and when all the advice is in place whether we should then call an SGM to vote through changes to be a 'stand alone club and be able to enter the Arena League as a single Club. Need to understand the rules of entry into Arena League and the dates we need to be a single club by if Chris agrees to enter. Committee members did not want to make a decision without information and advice. Sue requested that Chris' opinion is the most important as he has the 'performance training and competition planned and this will mean him or another coach running a team and attending .- Arena competitions are on Saturdays when Chris has 4 hours of Performance training.- Sean stated that there was no problem getting swimmers in the 11 years age group. He would help. The committee reminded that the team would have to start in the bottom division.

Compromise suggested that we get the new squad up and ready to run hopefully by March then we can call an SGM to change constitution and then the entry into Arena League can be agreed. (Nick proposed and committee agreed in principle). This will be subject to getting Chris' approval to this timescale.

Discussion on swimmers who are only TBAS members should pay annual ASA retention fees as well as monthly fees. Swimmers at present have 'Home Club' pay-may need change to constitution??- Emily to be asked for advice.

• 3. Speed of travel on the new squad (discuss and agree the way forward): Discussion on pool time and conversations with Team Bath Tribe: They should have more swimmers to recommend in March at the natural end of the course. Suggested that there be a lane on a Saturday for the 'transition of





swimmers alongside those from TBAS and the Tribe lessons- Jamie didn't think it was a good idea as could bring complaints from parents who train on Sunday. To discuss with Chris(Head Coach/training) and at Sub committee once pool time acquired.

- 4. Sub-committee for new development -members. Members Sean, Kate, Chris and Karen. To meet
  and work out a business plan to present to Emily. This committee will present at committee meetings
  only.
- 5. Bath Chronicle awards evening: Club to pay for Chris and Tilly to attend if they would like to. Julia to ask.
- Discussion on potential new committee members. Julia and Sue asked what they will do. Sue stated she had stood last year but had stayed on once the new secretary had decided not to carry on and her role was meant to have been filled during the year- she is happy to help the new secretary, but wants a break after 7 years of being a secretary at 3 different clubs. Julia said she would not just walk away, but she did feel she needed time out of the role. People suggested by Jamie have all refused.
- Sue reminded all people they need to fill in a Nomination form including those who want to stay on the committee.-none have been received so far -closing date is 6/11/17
