Promoter's Conditions

- 1. The meet will be held under ASA Laws and Regulations and ASA Technical Rules of Racing and has been Licensed Level 3 by the Swim England.
- 2. Entries of 5 or more swimmers from the same Club MUST be made electronically. Entries of 4 or less swimmers from the same club may be made using the official meet entry form.. Entries (including summary and payment) must reach the Meet Promoter on or before midnight on 15 August 2017. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Promoter.
- 3. All competitors should be accompanied by a coach/team manager, be registered ASA Category Two members, provide their ASA number, be members of an affiliated club, and enter under one club only.
- 4. Clubs are requested to supply a qualified Official for every 6 swimmers entered into the competition. However, Team Bath AS will not refuse entries from clubs who are unable to supply qualified Officials.
- 5. All participating officials will be provided with refreshments. An allowance will be available for travelling officials.
- 6. The promoter reserves the right to accept or reject entries and also restrict entries in order to complete the meet within the time available. If the meet is oversubscribed, entries will be accepted on a basis of first come first served. A list of rejected swimmers and a refund will be sent. Incorrect or incomplete entries will be rejected. Hy-tek files submitted missing a competitors' ASA number or date of birth will be considered incomplete and the entire file rejected. There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the closing date, except on production of a medical certificate.
- 7. The age groups are: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15+ ages as at 10th September 2017. Awards will be made for the top three in each age group specified.
- 8. The pool is 25m. . Anti-wave devices will be in place and electronic timing/placing will be used.
- 9. Entry times will be those for short course. Conversions from Long Course using ASA Equivallence tables will be accepted. Entry fee is £5 per event. Coach/team manager passes (maximum of 4 per club, are £10 each and entitle the holder to admission to all sessions, a programme plus a full set of results per club Spectators will be charged £4 admission on the day. Payment by cheque, if necessary, will be acceptable. Cheques should be made payable to Aquae Sulis Performance Swimming Club

- 10. Electronic payment is preferred. Please use the reference: ..."swimmername L3Sep17" or "clubname L3Sep17" for club entries. If you wish to pay by cheque (one per club), please make them payable to "Aquae Sulis Performance Swimming Club". Please write your bank reference on your entry form.
- 11. Entries and results for this meet will be held on computer. As required by the Data Protection Act 1998 submission of entries implies consent to the holding of personal information on computer. These details may be made public before, during or after the meet.
- 12. Entries will be pre-seeded into heats based on entry times, slowest heats swum first.
- 13. Swimmers must report to the competitors' stewards' eight heats prior to their own.





14. Swimmers who qualified for the:

2017 British Championships;

2016 ASA Short Course Championships;

Or any Swimmers who have been selected for events at the 2017 British Summer Championships, or 2017 Home National Championships

May not enter this competition.

- 15. Only swimmers reporting for their event and officials will be allowed on poolside during the meet. Coaches wearing a coach pass are allowed on poolside during warm-ups. During the warm-up coaches must adhere to the safety advice from the warm-up steward at all times, non compliance may lead to expulsion of their team from the meet. Wet swimmers are not allowed in the spectator areas and spectators are not allowed to sit with or enter the competitors seating area.
- 16. Neither the promoter nor Horfield Leisure Centre accept any liability for any loss or damage to personal belongings.
- 17. In case of an emergency or situations outside of the Promoter's control, during the meet, the conditions may be amended by the Referee to ensure the smooth running of the meet. Any matter not covered by these conditions shall be at the Referee's discretion if not covered by ASA Laws and Regulations or Swim England Technical Rules of Racing.
- 18. Should it be necessary to cancel the meet, for reasons beyond the control of the promoter, refunds will not apply once the meet has commenced. Prior to commencement refunds may apply at the promoters discretion.
