## West Norfolk Swimming Club - Mini Meet Series 2016-17

#### Meet Rules and Information

This Competition is licensed as a Level 4 meet by the ASA and will be held under ASA Laws and Regulations, ASA Technical Rules of Racing and to ASA Open Meet Licensing Criteria

- Licensing at Level 4 allows for entry into events at County Championships and all results will be recorded in the ASA National Ranking database
- 2. The Mini Meet series comprises four individual gala sessions, comprising of time-trials for 9-13 year olds with a points based award system.
- The aim of the Mini Meet series is to give young swimmers added incentive to attend training sessions and to provide the ideal
  environment to gain valuable experience of Open Meet's on a small scale and to give the coaches an opportunity to assess the progress of
  their swimmers.
- 4. Competitors' ages shall be as at 7<sup>th</sup> January 2017 (the date of the final round)
- 5. Swimmers aged 8 may enter only if aged 9 by the final date of the series (7th January 2017). All swimmers must be ASA Category 1 or 2 members.
- 6. Swimmers who have achieved a time of 3:00.00 or faster for 200IM by the closing date may not enter (male or female). It is felt that once the swimmer reaches this standard the Mini Meets are no longer appropriate for the swimmer's development.
- 7. The final closing date is 12 noon on Friday 6th May 2016.
- The series will also provide swimmers with results based on a lowest cumulative time basis. (Points system to be confirmed before start of event).
- 9. Swimmers must enter all four rounds regardless of actual attendance and are expected to swim all three races in each round unless otherwise advised by their coach.
- 10. All events will be swum as mixed age groups and seeded on submitted times. All heats will be spearheaded.
- 11. Subsequent rounds will have entry times updated from the Mini Meet series only.
- 12. The swimmer entry fee shall be £40, which covers ALL four rounds. Refunds are not available.
- 13. The promoter will invite a maximum of 7 other clubs to take part in the series.
- 14. Individual entries from visiting clubs shall be made on the official entry form. If required confirmation of electronic entry format should be agreed with the Promotor prior to submission. Cheque payable to the West Norfolk Swimming Club or payment by BACS (account details on request if you wish to pay by BACS please <a href="mailtreasurer@westnorfolksc.co.uk">mailtreasurer@westnorfolksc.co.uk</a> for further details.
- 15. As this is licenced meet clubs are asked to assist with the provision of suitably qualified officials. Refreshments will be provided during the sessions. Parents are encouraged to develop skills as trainee officials and helpers in running the series.
- 16. Each visiting club is requested **to provide two qualified officials for every round**. If it will not be possible to meet this request, it is essential that this is made clear when returning entries.
- 17. Please provide contact details for your official's secretary when returning entries. Alternatively email West Norfolk Officials Secretary at <a href="mailto:liaison@westnorfolksc.co.uk">liaison@westnorfolksc.co.uk</a>.
- 18. This is a first come first served meet. If the number of swims from invited clubs exceeds the number that can be accommodated in Round 1, the promoter reserves the right to limit entries. The slowest competitors will be rejected to bring the number of swims down to the number that can be accommodated..
- 19. The list of accepted and rejected entries will be published / available for download on the club website <a href="www.westnorfolksc.co.uk">www.westnorfolksc.co.uk</a> approximately two weeks prior to the competition. It is the competing club/swimmer's responsibility to check this list for accuracy and advise immediately of any mistakes or changes that are required.
- 20. No on the day entries will be accepted.
- 21. The pool length is 25 metres, 6 lanes with anti-wave ropes and electronic timing.
- 22. Competitors must report to the marshalling area in a timely manner, normally one event in advance of their own, where they will be given their start order. Any swimmer not reporting may be deemed to have withdrawn from that event
- 23. Results sheets will be displayed during each round. Within 24hours of the end of each round the results will be available on the West Norfolk Swimming Club website <a href="https://www.westnorfolksc.co.uk">www.westnorfolksc.co.uk</a>

- 24. The following awards with be presented at the end of the Round 4:
  - Top points scoring swimmer overall Female
  - Top points scoring swimmer overall Male
  - Top 6, boys and girls in each event and age group for 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13 years based on highest points score in each event.
- 25. Team Managers/Coaches will be allowed on poolside if wearing a pre-purchased pass. Passes can be requested with the entry forms and will be £15 each total, this will cover all 4 sessions. Coaches and Team Managers must be club trained personnel and clubs are asked to maintain a ratio of 1:10
- 26. The Referee reserves the right in the interests of time to operate 'OVER THE TOP' starts, with the exception of Back Stroke
- 27. Coaches to submit withdrawal forms prior to each session warm-up. Please collect these on arrival at the individual meet sessions
- 28. The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
- 29. The promoters do not accept responsibility for any individuals property. Designated areas for bag storage will be identified on the day. No bags will be allowed on poolside.
- 30. West Norfolk SC uses a computer to manage entries and results. By submitting and accepting entries to the meet, consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer. Personal data handled (name, club, recorded/entered times) may be made public during or after the meet.
- 31. Individual event programmes will be available for each session
- 32. Closing date for entries is Noon on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2016.
- 33. All persons wishing to use photographic equipment including mobile phones with image capturing facility must register at the entrance desk. **No photographs are permitted poolside**.
- 34. Please help to maintain a high standard of health and safety by not blocking emergency exits and walkways with bags and report any issues immediately to a member of the pool staff or to the Open Meet Promoter.
- 35. Warm up protocol: Strictly no diving during any warm-up sessions, except in the designated sprint lanes, odd lanes will swim clockwise (1, 3, 5) even lanes (2, 4, 6) will swim counter clockwise. All swimmers must leave the water by the side of the pool and not over the timing pads. Coaches should manage the lanes their swimmers are using during the warm up sessions. Guidance will be given by the meet announcer.
- 36. Subject to entry numbers Spectator Tickets may be issued to each participating club pro-rata based on swimmer numbers
- 37. Shoes must not be worn in the changing room area, overshoes may be provided for spectator entry to poolside
- 38. Any situation not covered by the above will be at the discretion of the promoters, who also reserve the right to make any changes that may be considered necessary for the smooth running and discipline of the event.
