A Triumphant Weekend for Blue Fins

From 26th-28th October 13 Senior and Masters swimmer from Bicester Blue Fins competed at the Swim England Masters National Championships. This short course event took place at Ponds Forge in Sheffield and the squad put in some exceptional swims returning triumphantly with 14 medals in including three golds.

Mike Procter (25) took a spectacular three golds from his four events taking to the podium in the 50m freestyle, 50m fly and 100m fly. An elated Mike said “None of us expected to achieve as much as we did, but we have all worked really hard and sacrificed a lot particularly over the past three months. It feels so good that it paid off and we are all really enjoying the moment now and for some time to come!”

Ryan Steward had an outstanding Championship claiming two silver and two bronze medals from seven events. Andy Smith and Noah Cadle also excelled and took home individual medals. The Men’s relay team did not disappoint with incredible performances claiming two silvers and a bronze from their three races.

Ben Inness (17) lead the way with an incredible three gold medals, five silvers and one bronze. Seb Gomm (12) bagged four silvers and Tom Henley (12) a gold and a silver. Other medallists were Ethan Cavill, Alex Pryce, Luca Soleil-Arnephys and Freddie Whybrow.

Coach Darren Inness said “it was a fantastic Meet for our swimmers. Every individual excelled with some securing PB’s in every event, with the squad achieving a 64% PB rate overall. Poolside the atmosphere was amazing too and we all came away very pleased and proud”.

It has been an exceptional weekend for Bicester Blue Fins, one which will be celebrated for some time and remembered always.
