Promoter's Conditions

1. The meet will take place at Haslemere Leisure Centre on Sunday 14th April 2024 and is licensed by Swim England at Level 3 under Licence number 3SE240424.
2. The meet will be run in accordance with and held under Swim England Laws, Swim England technical rules of Swimming and these conditions.
3. Competitors must be registered with Swim England as Club Compete (Category 2) and may enter in the name of one club only. Entries will only be accepted from competitors registered as members of Swim England, SASA or WASA or competitors from a country affiliated to FINA.
4. The promoter is Anissa Pieterse on behalf of Haslemere, Farnham and Godalming Swimming Clubs internalmeets.fsc@outlook.com
5. The age groups for open/males and females are 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16+. The female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
6. Ages are as at 14th April 2024
7. The opening date for entries is Sunday 18th February and closing date Sunday 31st March at midnight or sooner if the meet is full.
8. Medals will be presented to the first 3 in each age group in each event.
9. The pool is 25m anti Wave lane ropes will be in place and AOE will be used. A secondary strobe for the starting system is available.
10. Heats will be swum as mixed age with swimmers seeded by entry times.
11. Over the top starts may be used at the referee's discretion.

12. Upper cut off times are provided. Entry times will be checked against British Swimming Rankings. Short course or converted long course times will be accepted. If the event is undersubscribed the spaces may be offered to swimmers with no time, with priority being given to clubs with the highest number of entries

14. Complete entries for each club are required together with a single cheque or electronic payment. Individual entries will be accepted at the Promoter's discretion.
15. The entry fee is £7.50 per race with a £10 surcharge for individual entries.
16. Entry shall be by an Individual Entry Form or by Hytek file for club entry. The required Entry File for the meet will be available on both the Haslemere and Farnham club websites.
17. Payment for entries and coach passes should be on a single cheque, made payable to "Haslemere Swimming Club".

18. The Promoter reserves the right to limit entries and the number of heats in any event to maintain a balanced programme. In the event that entries are rejected, fees will be refunded by a single payment to the club in question.
19. Accepted and rejected entries will be posted on the club website after the closing date.
20. We will be operating a **Sign Out system**. Coaches/Team Managers must lodge any withdrawals within 15 minutes of the start of warm up in each session. A fine of £10 may be levied in respect of each competitor who fails to withdraw and does not present themselves at the start of the event (except in the case of genuine illness or a proven emergency).
21. Competitors for the first event must report to the marshalling area immediately after each warm up. For the other events, competitors should report when called.

It is the swimmers and coaches responsibility that they report to the marshalls on time

There will be NO announcements calling late swimmers

22. Coaches' passes will be issued at a cost of £15 per day and will include refreshments. Team Manager passes are also available free of charge to enable clubs to fulfil the Swim England ratio requirements. These will not include refreshments. Extra TM passes in excess of Swim England supervisory ratios will be charged at £5 per session. There will be no entry to poolside without a pass and passes must be worn at all times.
23. All clubs submitting entries are requested to assist in the running of the meet by supplying details of Licensed officials who are willing to assist.

24. Results will be available through Meet Mobile and emailed to clubs after the competition and will be supplied to British Swimming for entry into the national rankings database.

25. In accordance with the Swim England Child Safeguarding Policies and Procedures, any parents or carers of swimmers under the age of 18 who wish to take photographic or video images are requested to focus on their own child as much as reasonably possible and to avoid including other children in those images.
Should you have any concerns about photography or filming please bring them to the attention of the promoter.
Participants and spectators are requested to follow the Swim England guidelines for photography and use of photographs on social media.
The Swim England Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures, Wavewater 2020-23 Section 2.4 provides guidance on the use of social networking (page 92-95) and guidance on photography (page 86–88). <https://www.swimming.org/swimengland/wavewater-child-safeguarding-for-clubs/> .
Both sets of guidance apply if social media platforms are being used to share images or recordings either after the meet or during live streaming of the event.
26. All participants must observe the safety precautions in operation at Haslemere Leisure centre. Neither the Promoter nor Haslemere Swimming Club will be responsible for any loss or damage occurring during the meet.
27. The Junior Pool will be closed throughout the gala and must not be used.
28. The Data Protection Act 2018 requires us to provide you with certain information and to obtain your consent before processing data about you. Processing includes: obtaining, recording, holding, disclosing, destruction or retaining information. We require certain personal data for the purposes of making entries to the competition, managing the meet and the submission of results to Rankings. The information provided by you will be processed in accordance with the Data Protection Act 2018. Consent to process such personal data is deemed to have been given by the submission of the entry. Where the personal data of competitors, officials and coaches/team managers has been passed to us by a third party such as a club rather than by the individuals themselves, we rely on the third party to ensure that consent has been obtained.
29. Spectators are welcome. There will be a charge of £4 per session or £10 for all 3 sessions.
30. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to Swim England Laws, Regulations and Technical Rules of Racing.
