Erith and District Swimming Club invite your swimmers to compete in our Licensed Level 3 Open Meet at Crook Log Leisure Centre, Brampton Road, Bexleyheath, Kent DA7 4HH on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> September 2022.

Our Super Sunday Sprint Meet programme has been put together with the aim of giving swimmers the opportunity to compete in all four of the 50m Sprint events in one session.

Everyone was pleased with the changed programme that we ran in 2021, so we have not altered the structure for 2022. In order that we can suitably manage numbers and pool time allocation, swimmers are required to enter all 4 of the 50m sprint events available to them for the price of £15. The entering of events singly is not permitted. If a swimmer chooses not to swim an event, there is a procedure in place (see Promoters Conditions) to allow them to withdraw. **Only Club entries using the Hy-Tek electronic meet entry file will be permitted.** This is easily imported into Hy-Tek's Team Manager, [TM Lite](#), [SwimClub Manager](#) or TeamUnify. This, and other information relating to the meet, is available to view and download from [HERE](#).

Awards will be made to the fastest 6 swimmers in each stroke in the following age groups: 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs and to the fastest 3 swimmers in the 15yrs & 16yrs and over. A trophy will be presented to the top swimmer in each of the age groups with the fastest accumulated overall time for the four 50m sprint events.

Confirmed entries and real time results will also be available via Hy-Tek's [Meet Mobile App](#). All results will also be made available on our website: <https://www.edsc.org.uk/page/edsc-meet-results/28551> as soon as possible after the event.

There is ample car parking available at the Leisure Centre.

#### Promoter's Conditions

- 1: This competition is promoted by Erith and District Swimming Club which is affiliated to Swim England London Region. It is to be held under Swim England Laws and Technical rules of swimming and Promoter's Conditions. The event is licensed by Swim England for entry to County and Regional events. The event will be held in an eight lane 25 metre pool with electronic timing pads and display. There is a secondary strobe on the starting machine.
- 2: Ages are as at midnight on 25<sup>th</sup> September 2022. It is the swimmers responsibility to ensure his/her eligibility for each event. All swimmers must be registered as Category 2 with Swim England.
- 3: All events will be swum on a HDW basis. All heats will be spearheaded. All starts will be at the deep end of the pool and over the top starts will be at the discretion of the Referee.
- 4: Closing date for entries is 6pm on Friday 9<sup>th</sup> September 2022.
- 5: One combined entry per Club with one payment is required. Clubs will need to submit entries electronically using [Hy-Tek's TM Lite](#). Further details on how to do this are available as part of the electronic entry pack. Paper entries are not permitted. No entries will be accepted after the closing date or during the meet unless due to Promoter's error or omission.
- 6: Entries will not be registered unless accompanied by the correct fee.
- 7: Coaches and Team Managers' Passes are £15 to include admittance to poolside at all sessions and refreshments. Coaches will not be allowed on poolside without a Pass.
- 8: Coaches and Team Managers' Passes must be ordered using the Club Entry Form.
- 9: A card-less entry system will operate at the gala. There will be no sign in. All swimmers will be entered in to every event they are registered for. Swimmers wishing to withdraw from an event / events should do so by e-mailing [openmeetentries@edsc.org.uk](mailto:openmeetentries@edsc.org.uk) by 6pm on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> September.
- 10: Competitors must report to the Clerks of the Course in the marshalling area when called. Competitors not reporting in time for an event may be excluded.
- 11: Competitors must leave the pool by the steps at the sides of the pool and not climb over the electronic pads.
- 12: Awards will be made to the fastest 6 swimmers in each stroke in the following age groups: 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs and to the fastest 3 swimmers in the 15yrs & 16yrs plus age groups, with a trophy being presented to the top swimmer in each of the age groups with the fastest accumulated overall time for the four 50m events.

13: Competitors are only allowed on poolside for the session in which they are competing. They must also cover up and wear shoes when leaving the poolside area. It is not permitted to bring glass containers on to poolside. All rubbish must be taken off of poolside when leaving.

14: Entries must be no faster than the Upper Limit Time published for each event. The Promoter reserves the right to restrict the number of entries to meet allocated pool time. Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis.

15: Time trials will be permitted (for swimmers who are faster than the Upper Limit Time). Entries submitted that are faster than the stated Upper Limit Times will be automatically entered as Time Trials meaning that the swimmer will swim for time only and will not be eligible for an award. Their time will be submitted to Swim England Rankings.

16: There may be a limit on the number of swimmers per session. In the event that the Meet become's oversubscribed then entries from swimmers whose entry times are under the Upper Limit Time for all 4 events will take precedence over those received from swimmers who have submitted entries that are faster than the Upper Limit Time and considered as Time Trials.

17: The Promoter reserves the right to alter the schedule if circumstances demand.

18: Any item not covered within these conditions will be at the discretion of the Promoter.

19: Clubs are requested to check entry lists before the date of the gala as errors are harder to rectify on the day.

20: By submitting and accepting entries to the meet consent is hereby given, as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information. The personal information supplied with your entry will be retained securely and will only be used for the legitimate purposes of running the event. This data will be shared by form of results with Swim England (Rankings) and the clubs who have entered the meet. A full copy of the results will be published on the website after the meet. Please be aware that links from our website may take you to external websites that are not covered by our policies. Please ensure that you review their privacy policies before any data is submitted. If any persons want to exercise their right to erasure or processing of their personal data they will need to make a written request to the promoter. We will only hold competition data for 12 months after which it will be destroyed and erased from our systems.

21: PHOTOGRAPHY: Anyone wishing to take still or digital photography (including using mobile phones to do this) must do so in accordance with the Swim England Child Safeguarding Policy and Procedures (Wavepower). Flash photography is prohibited at all times.

#### **Additional Covid procedures and protocols**

Erith & District Swimming Club looks forward to welcoming you to our Super Sunday Sprint Meet. The promoter reserves the right to adapt this meet to align with UK government guidance and policies on Covid restrictions.

The meet will only take place if Covid restrictions allow and is currently being planned on the assumption that no social distancing rules will be in place. The club are working with the team at Crook Log Leisure Centre to ensure that this meet can operate safely. Everyone involved has a duty to protect each other.

If restrictions require us to cancel the meet, entry fees will be refunded.

If anyone planning to attend the meet has any Covid symptoms, they must not attend. We will continue to monitor government guidance with regards to self-isolation for those who have been in contact with someone who has tested positive and ask that anyone involved with the meet abide by the guidance available at the time.

Clubs must have current contact details for all swimmers, team managers, coaches and officials attending in case these are required for track and trace purposes. Clubs will be responsible for the swimmers from their club whilst at the meet and should bring sufficient team managers for the number of swimmers in each session.

We will only be accepting club entries. There will be no individual entries due to requirement for Team Managers

Swimmers are not permitted on to the pool deck unless it is a session in which they are competing. The pool deck will be cleared at the end of each session and only once cleared will the next set of swimmers be allowed in to the Centre. There will be no sign in on the day. Swimmers will be entered for all of their events. If a swimmer wishes to withdraw then they should do so by 6pm on Friday the 23<sup>rd</sup> September by e-mailing [openmeetentries@edsc.org.uk](mailto:openmeetentries@edsc.org.uk).

Spectators numbers may be limited at each session. To allow us to manage numbers in the balcony, anyone wishing to spectate **must** purchase an entry ticket in advance by clicking [HERE](#). Once you have purchased your ticket you will receive an e-mail confirmation of your order. Please retain this confirmation as you will need it on the day to gain access to the balcony. The balcony will be cleared at the end of each session and only once cleared will the next set of spectators be allowed in to the Centre.

There will be no printed programmes. Everyone involved is encouraged to use the [Meet Mobile App](#) to view heat sheets and results. Heat Sheets will be published and available [HERE](#) after 6pm on Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> September once sign out has closed.

There will be two 15-minute warm ups for each session and clubs will be allocated lanes and times during each session. Warm ups will be mixed gender and clubs are requested to group swimmers of similar ability together to ease the flow of swimmers.

Results will be published throughout the meet on the [Meet Mobile App](#). They will not be posted on poolside or on the balcony as normal in order to avoid congestion.

Awards will be provided to clubs for distribution to their swimmers as soon as possible after each event.
