



The Disability Officer would play a key role with those working with disability athletes within Redhill and Reigate Swimming club.

The role entails the following:

- A well organised and efficient person who has some knowledge of the club and an interest in disability swimming and who is a confident and effective communicator
- To liaise with parents of disabled swimmers
- To represent the views and needs of disability swimming on the committee.
- To engage with the local, regional and national disability swimming network
- To arrange disability awareness training for club volunteers, teachers and coaches
- To identify any additional training needs within the Club in relation to providing opportunities for disabled people
- To ensure that any disabled swimming members are aware of the training and competitive swimming opportunities available to them, both within and external to the ASA
- To promote positively opportunities for disabled people through club publicity materials to follow and promote the ASA Child Protection policy
