



Redhill & Reigate Swimming Club – Masters memberships

Swimmers joining the Masters section of RRSC have a number of membership options, as outlined below:

1. Pay the annual membership fee (currently £55¹) and choose to either
 - a. Join one of the “regular” training groups and pay monthly (£24¹ per month for 1 hour per week, £30¹ per month for 2 hours per week), or
 - b. Join as a pay as you go (PAYG) member, £6 per session attended
2. No annual membership fee and join as a pay as you go (PAYG) at £7 per session attended

In all cases the appropriate Swim England membership fee is payable. These amounts are set by Swim England and must be paid in full to the Club before being eligible to swim with our Masters team.

Members who have joined one of the regular training groups (ie 1a above) may amend their membership to PAYG (under 1b) at any time by providing sufficient notice to the Treasurer and Membership Secretary (as they decide).

Those joining as PAYG members may amend their membership to the regular training group at any time by providing sufficient notice to the Treasurer and Membership Secretary (as they decide). Those who initially joined under option 2 above, on transferring to the regular training group the annual membership fee will become payable.

PAYG fees

In joining the PAYG membership, you will be committing to remit the fees for the sessions you attend by BACS transfer to the Club account. The appropriate amounts would be paid on a monthly basis (in arrears). Payments would be due on the 1st of the month following those to which the attended sessions relate (for example, payment for sessions attended during April 2019 would be payable on 1 May 2019). Payment should be made promptly and will be cross-checked against the attendance recorded by the Coaches in Team Unify.²

Cash payments or cheques will not be accepted.
