REPORT FOR THE YEAR ENDING 30th SEPTEMBER, 1974

The past year has been one of the most difficult in the history of the Club. When the Major Pool closed in September 1973 the effects were not felt immediately but since it was not to open in 1974 the loss of its use during the summer had a very serious impact on all aspects of the Club. We lost facilities for training swimming and water polo fixtures, and the income from fixtures and spectators on club nights who usually enjoy the comfort of the Major Pool. To compensate partly for the loss of training facilities we hired another pool. We had to play all our water polo matches away from home and to reduce our swimming fixtures to away matches only. All this had to be paid for and resulted in a £365 deficit on the year's working. We have a reserve fund carefully built up over the years and we are able to carry on. The plan to repair the Major Pool was approved in July and in order to avoid another year's loss on the same scale it is vital that the work be completed in time to re-open the pool in the summer of 1975.

We are determined that our competitive swimmers should not suffer and we are able to provide them with special training facilities as good as they had previously enjoyed. The excellent results in the National and County Championships with many new record times, the best we have had for some years, show that they had not been at a disadvantage and in 1975 we shall provide them with the same training facilities and expect to get even better results.

Our first priority for 1975 is to get the Major Pool open as soon as possible. Anything that members and supporters can do to hasten its opening will be of great value to the Club.

The Club has a very good group of instructors on the bathside who do great work at all levels and help produce the champions. Away from the bathside there are those who help with the finance and administration of the Club. The Committee and all members are grateful to them for their valuable and unselfish work.

Competitive Activities

Although these were somewhat restricted our successes were not. Early in the year we maintained our high position in the Swimming League and followed this with our most successful season for many years in Sussex Championships, winning far more than any other Club. In the Sussex Age Group Competitions our junior swimmers did well and the girls won the Girls Trophy. However, the boys did not retain their trophy because a number of boys failed to swim in events in which they had been entered.

Congratulations go to the following swimmers on their successes -

David Dunne who had a most successful season. He won the Welsh A.S.A. 200 metres Freestyle Championship and gained places in the 100 metres Freestyle, 100 metres Butterfly and 200 metres Individual Medley. On these performances he was selected to represent Wales in the Eight Nations Meeting in Oslo. He gained places in the 100 metres Freestyle and 100 metres Butterfly in the Welsh A.S.A. Short Course Championships and qualified to swim in the A.S.A. Short Course Championships. He also won four Sussex County Championships and the Brighton Pier to Pier Race. Sian Dunne who recorded some fine performances in the Welsh A.S.A. Championships being 2nd in the Junior 200 metres Individual Medley and 3rd in the Junior 100 metres Butterfly as well as being 4th in the Senior 200 metres Individual Medley and 200 metres Butterfly. She also won the Sussex County A.S.A. 100 metres Butterfly Championship in record time. Lucy Hilder who was 7th in the A.S.A. Age Group 100 metres Breaststroke Championship; 4th in the English Schools 12-14 years 100 metres Breaststroke Championship; 1st in the Southern Counties Inter Counties 12/13 years 100 metres Freestyle and 100 metres Breaststroke and won the Sussex County Junior 110 metres Breaststroke in record time. Susan Grimsdale on winning the Sussex County A.S.A. Girls 100 metres Freestyle and 100 metres Backstroke Championships. To all those who swam in the County Team Championships and helped us to win six of the eight events, four in record time.

Finance

The loss of the use of the Major Pool was the main cause of the deficit of £365 on the year's working. Membership was down by about 10% and so were subscriptions. Bath admissions were also down but the revenue from them was up because of the increase of one penny on club night admission charges. Revenue from spectators showed an alarming drop due to the lack of seating in the Minor Pool. Cost of travel rose sharply due to the fact that all swimming and water polo fixtures took place in away baths and rising prices due to inflation and oil costs made things even worse. The deficit has been met from reserves, but the Club could not continue to sustain losses at this rate for very long. In order to meet some of the anticipated increase in costs during the coming year admission charges on club nights have been increased by 33% to 8p and 12p. The financial outlook will, however be bleak until the Major Pool opens again. Water Polo

Again the loss of the Major Pool naturally had an adverse effect on our water polo activities; nevertheless, congratulations are due to all those who endeavoured to produce results 2.

which cannot be considered other than very satisfactory.

In the second division of the National League we again finished fourth with 15 points, having won 7 games, drawn 1 and lost 6. This compares with 21 points in the previous season, but this year there were only 8 teams in the second division.

David West has again increased his tally of National League goals netting 34 times during this season, which puts him amongst the leading goal scorers in our division of the league; a commendable effort on David's part. Next among our players was 'Budgie' Baxter with 24 goals, followed by Chris Hollingdale with 17.

We were fortunate in being able to play three of our home games at Worthing during August, all of which we won. It was gratifying to see quite an enthusiastic audience of spectators, who outnumbered those who usually come to the King Alfred.

We have played in three friendly tournaments, again with very creditable results. We won the Maidstone tournament, and were second in those at Otter and Bracknell.

Our Junior Squad again did well, reaching the final of the Southern Counties 'Knock-out' Competition, where they were unlucky to meet Sutton and Cheam, who are the best 'under 18's side' in the country. We would, however, now like to see more enthusiasm amongst our juniors, as it is no good waiting until you are a senior and then expecting to become a member of our National League squad. In particular, Saturday evening Junior Water Polo training is being poorly attended at the moment, and unless there is an improvement in attendance we shall be forced to discontinue the session.
