Conditions

1. The promoter; Chris Mann, Treasurer, Stevenage Swimming Club
2. This competition will be held under ASA Laws and Regulations, ASA Technical Rules of Racing and to ASA Open Meet Licensing Criteria.
3. Swimmers must be category 1 or 2 ASA Registered in order to compete.
4. The event will take place on Sunday 23rd September, Sunday 14th October and Sunday 28th October 2018.
5. Entries for Session 1 should be received no later than **Sunday 16th September**. Other entries must be received no later than **Sunday 7th October**.
6. Age for competition is age as at 31st December 2018.
7. The pool length is 25 metres, 6 lanes with anti-turbulence ropes.
8. The Promoter reserves the right to reject entries if events are over-subscribed based on a first come first served basis. Rejections will be on an event and session basis to ensure that each session does not over run its allotted time.
9. The Promoter also reserves the right to accept entries after the closing date in order to ensure the meet is full. These will be accepted on a first come first served basis and only where there is room in the relevant event.
10. Competitors will be listed on the programme in graduated time order, slowest first. Swimmers who do not submit an entry time for an event will be accepted but will be seeded slowest in the heats of the event.
11. All events will be run as timed finals. Awards will be made to the top 3 swimmers in each age group in each individual event.
12. Warm ups will be divided into two 10 minute sessions. Girls and Boys separately.
13. Only competing swimmers, officials, and accredited coaches/team managers will be allowed on poolside.
14. Only under exceptional circumstances, and only with the permission of the Referee, will a swimmer be allowed to swim out of the pre-determined order.
15. Swimmers must wear suitable clothing and footwear on poolside. Swimmers wearing wet clothing are NOT allowed in the spectator seating area.
16. In the event of a false start swimmers must perform a safe, shallow entry dive and NOT fall into the water. The promoter's reserve the right in the interest of time to operate 'Over The Top Starts' if required at the referee's discretion.
17. Any matter not covered by these conditions will be determined by the Promoter and Referee, subject to ASA Laws, Regulations and the ASA Technical Rules of Racing
18. The promoter cannot accept liability for any losses or damage to property that may occur.
19. The promoter reserves the right to refuse entry to any person.
20. Entries to the meet will be held on a computer and consent, as required by the Data Protection Act
