CAPS AND KIT.

Caps.

All swimmers are welcome to purchase the yellow "Stowmarket" club swimming cap although for training sessions any swimming caps may be worn.

Upon swimming at an away time trial gala, summer or winter league meets or the club's No Frills gala, i.e., representing Stowmarket where other clubs are competing, swimmers qualify to wear the blue "Stowmarket" competition cap. At all subsequent galas Stowmarket swimmers should wear the blue competition cap.

(For the avoidance of doubt, swimming in an in-house gala does not qualify for the entitlement to wear the blue hat).

Upon achieving qualification to the County Championships swimmers may wear the blue competition caps with their names printed on the sides.

If a swimmer achieves a time that qualifies for entry into a national event they may have a cap with "National Qualifier" printed after their name.

Caps may be purchased from the club desk during Friday training sessions. Bespoke caps with names and similar require special ordering.

Prices vary and caps are usually sold as close to cost price as is reasonable (after allowing for some rounding).

Kit.

Swimmers of all levels may purchase the club T shirt but for image and team unity we require that ALL swimmers representing the club at galas wear the T shirt.

Other kit such as shorts and hoodies is also available.

Kit is purchased direct from the supplier by being made on-line during specific ordering "windows". The link is available via the club's website. The ordering "windows" are announced on the website and club notice-board.

We strongly recommend that the option of having names printed on shirts and other kit is taken up. Kit getting mixed up is a perennial problem particularly at in-house galas.

Delivery of all kit is to the club where it is then distributed accordingly.

Prices of kit vary and are shown on the website at the time of ordering.

Fins, hand paddles and snorkels.

As swimmers advance through the squads they will be required to have fins, hand paddles and snorkels that are used in some training sessions. The specific kit required will be advised upon entering a particular squad.

Anyone purchasing such items might like to note that currently the leisure centre offers discounts to club members on some items of swimming attire and kit.
