Our COVID 19 Precautions

I need to reiterate that the processes that the club has put in place for both swimming and diving have been developed based on Government and Swim England rules and guidance and after careful risk assessments and liaison with Everyone Active. We know that our precautions, in some areas, go further than some other clubs, but they are the ASC rules that all our swimmers, of any age (including Masters), have agreed to abide by. They are not optional and are designed to keep everyone; swimmers, coaches, marshalls, operator's teams, and families safe.

Can I call on all parents to reinforce the need for all swimmers to strictly adhere to the rules at all times, this is serious and needs to be treated as such by all concerned.

If we see that something isn't working as expected or we think we can change a procedure and still maintain the same level of safety we will do so. For example, following a review of risks, coaches now have the option to not wear face coverings whilst poolside and while all swimmers are in the water.

So as COVID 19 continues to be our biggest concern along with all the very real challenges that it is bringing for families and businesses, we must remain vigilant.

As we go into the half term we need to be particularly careful; maintaining our high standards both at training and outside of training.

The basics remain Hands - Face - Space. If we continue to work hard and think about the people around us, we can keep each other and the whole ASC family safe and well.
